Jackson County And Forestry and Parks Department proposes to rehabilitate 4600 feet of trail north of Crawford Creek. This trail is very sandy and erodes causing washouts during rain events. There are 2 to 3 feet banks along the trail from the past heavy use channelizing the water down the middle of the trail. We will taper the banks relieving the steepness but would not able to remedy all of the erosion. Planning adding 12 inches of 1 1/2 gravel plus fines that compact to 8 inches this will eliminate any further trail erosion. This trail is open to ATV's all year and UTV's in the summer.



Trail Project Detailed Description

Jackson County And Forestry and Parks Department proposes to rehabilitate 4600 feet of trail north of Crawford Creek. This trail is very sandy and erodes causing washouts during rain events. When the trail is wet it is like quick sand and when it is dry it's like blow sand. Trail is so heavily used and groomed weekly in the summer that the sand has no binder left to hold it in place. There are 2 to 3 feet banks along the trail from the past heavy use channelizing the water down the middle of the trail. We will taper the banks relieving the steepness but would not able to remedy all of the erosion. Planning adding up to a foot of 1 1/2 gravel plus fines that compact to 8 inches this will eliminate any further trail erosion. This trail is open to ATV's all year and UTV's in the summer.

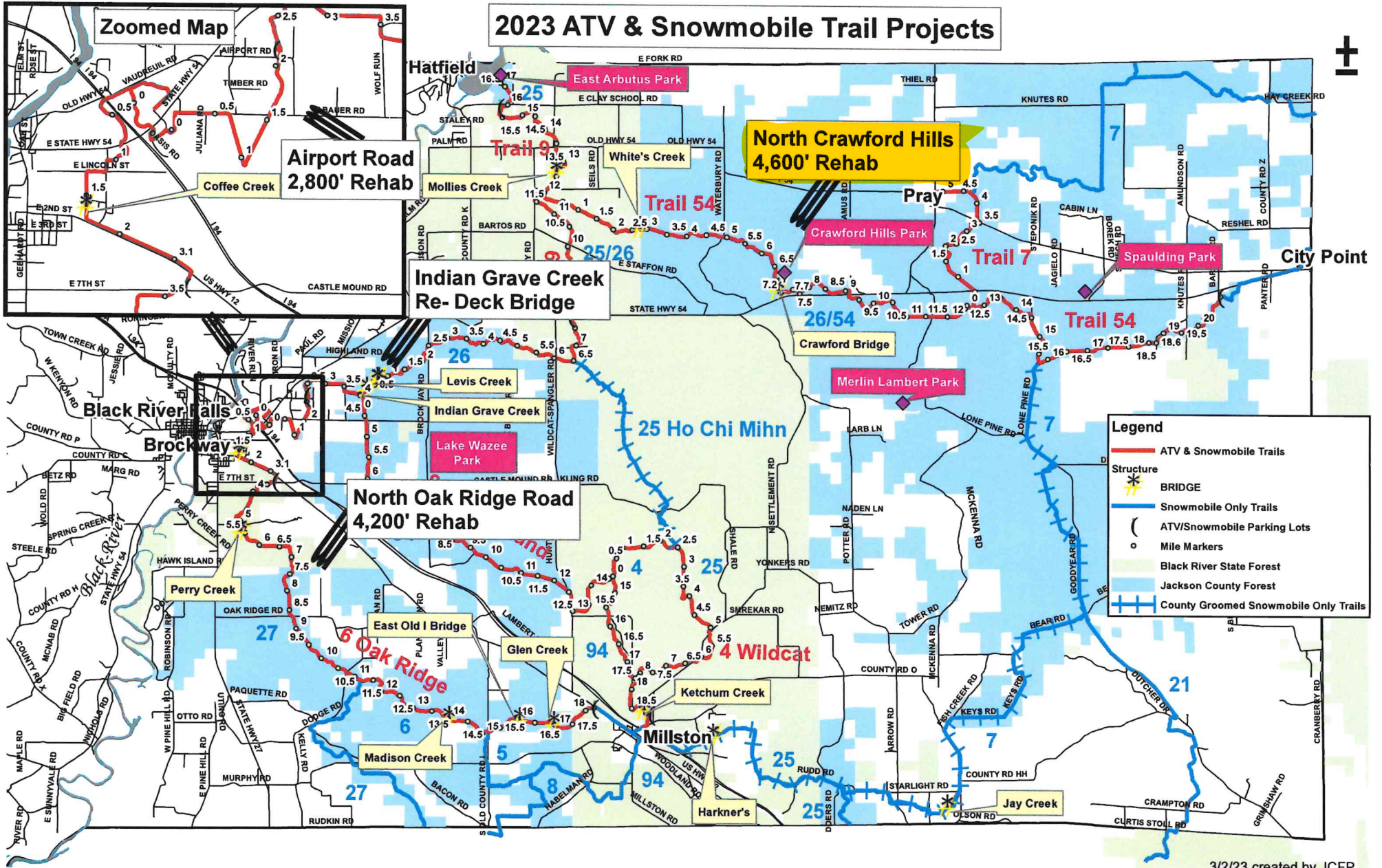

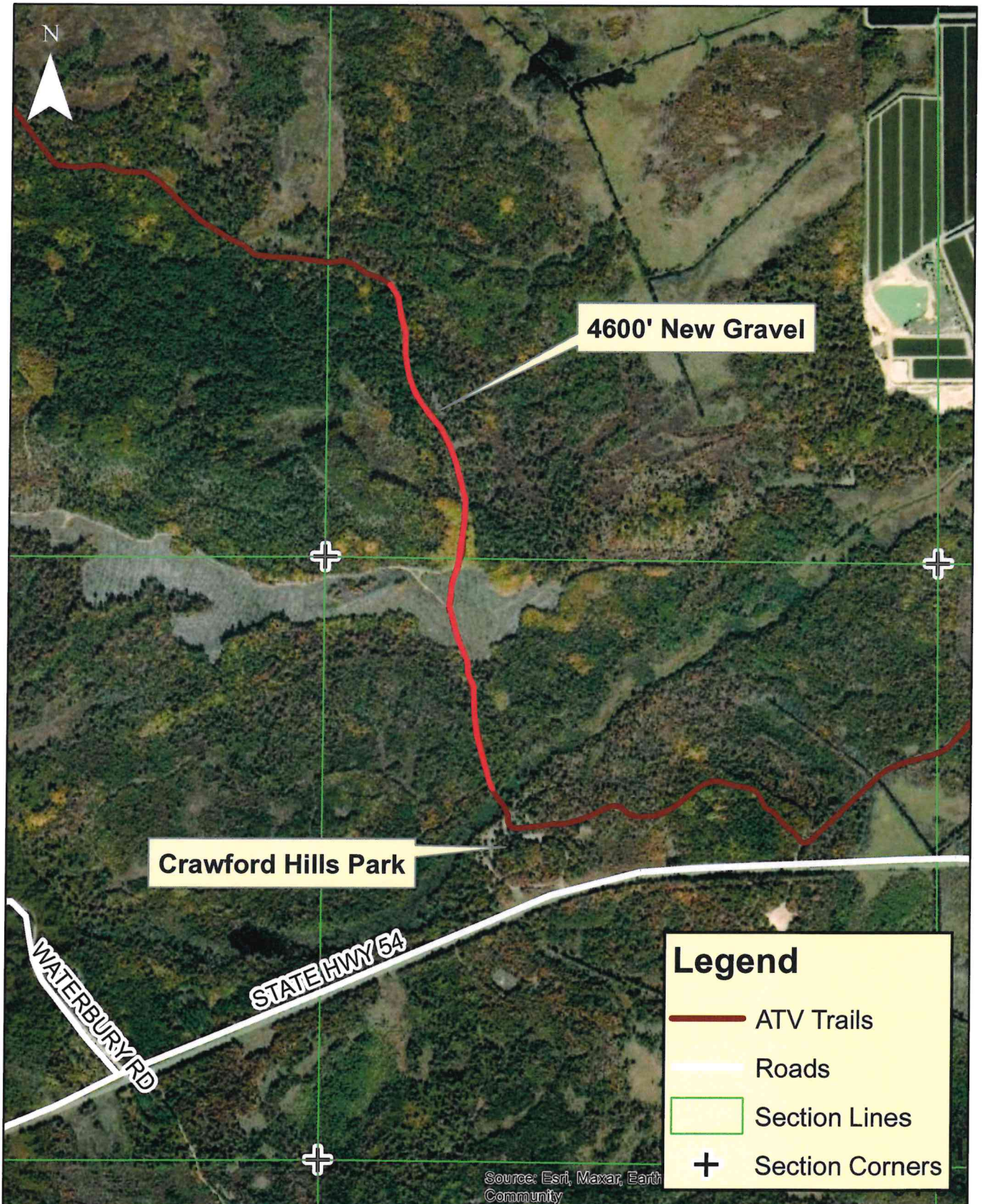

Aerial Photo Map

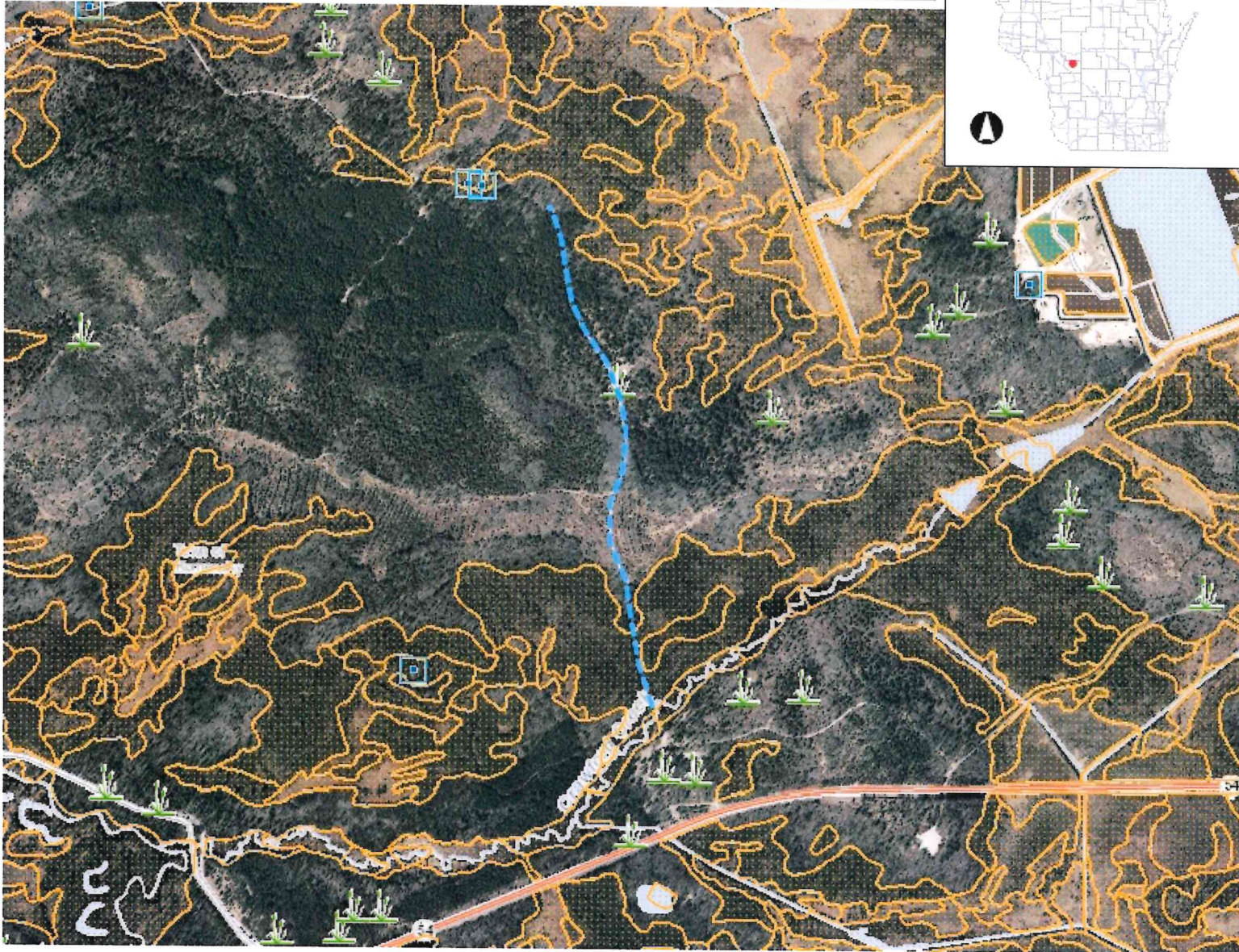

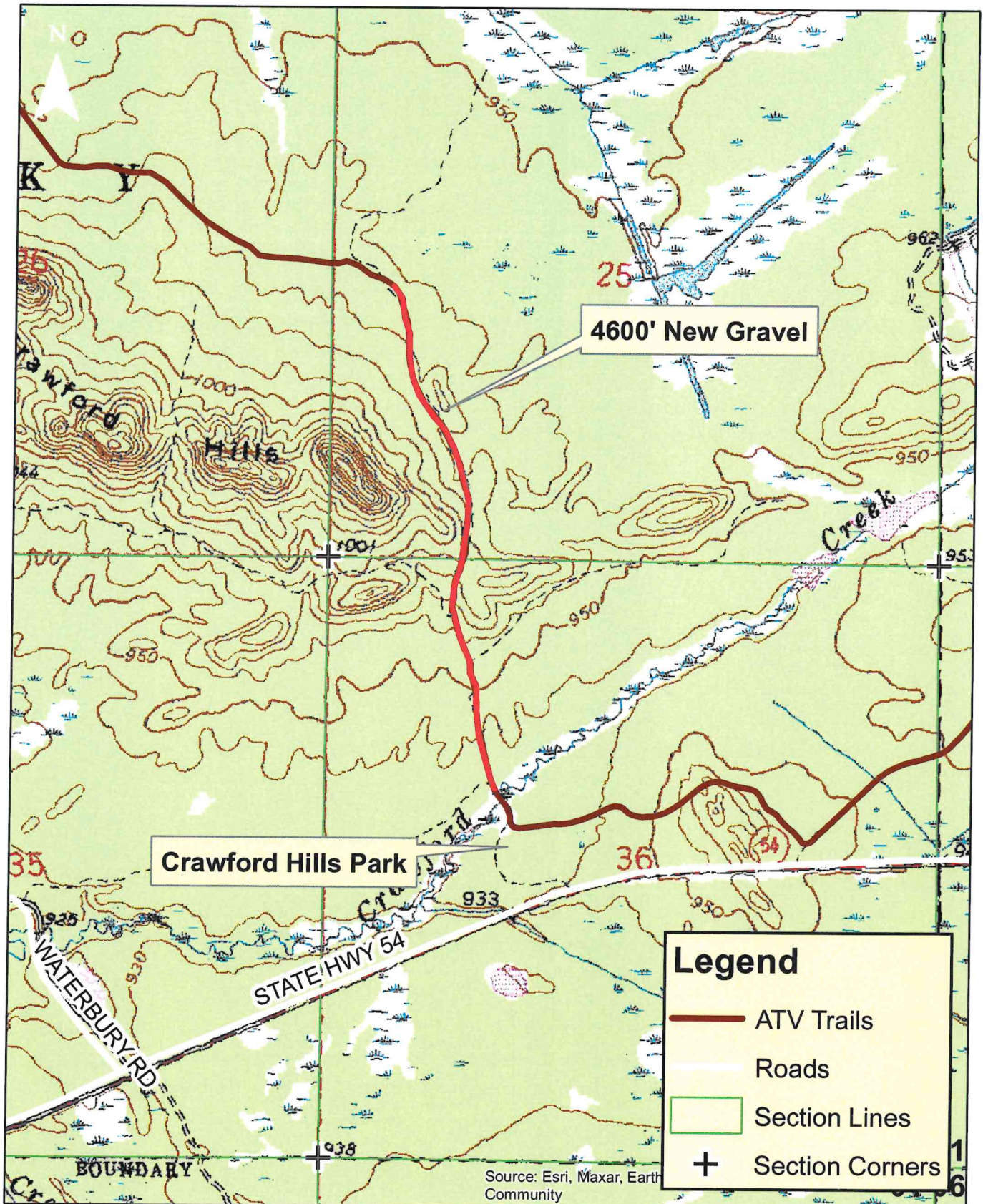

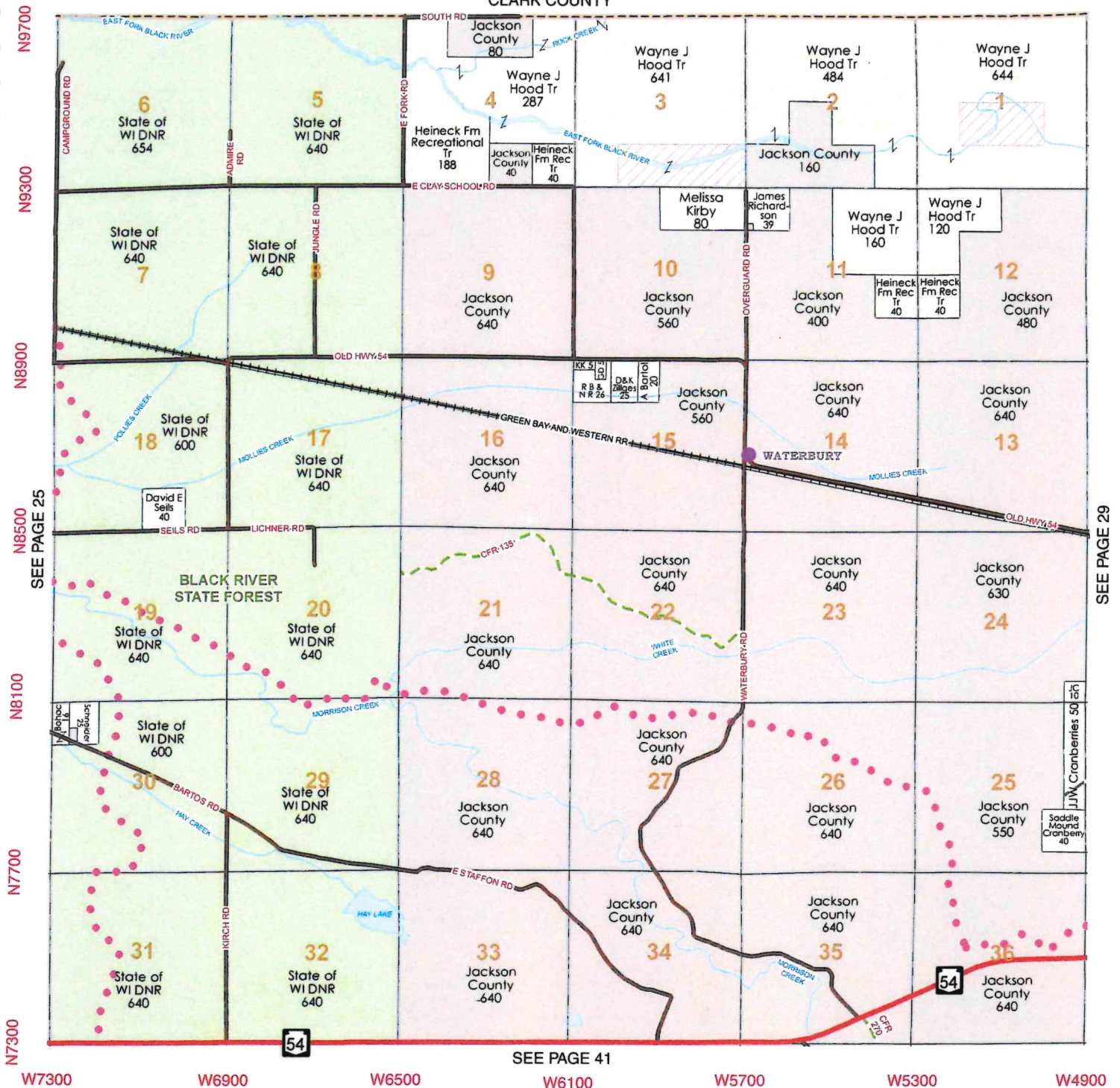
