Project Description Summary

The County Hwy H bridge that spans the Prairie River is due to be replaced in 2026 with engineering beginning in fall of 2023. This bridge has been used as a snowmobile crossing for many years to cross the Prairie River on the roadway. In an effort to provide a safer crossing, we propose to add a recreation wing on the new bridge that will allow for two way traffic. This segment of trail is heavily used in th Parrish area.

The replacement of the highway bridge creates a very cost effective way to get a permanent snowmobile crossing on the Prairie River that will greatly improve safety and the experience of the riders. All permitting and H&H study costs will be completed as part of the highway project. The anticipated lifespan of the new bridge will be greater than 80 years.

Langlade County winter ATV trails open 10 days after snowmobile trails open and only when the temperature is below 28 degrees.

Bridge Project Detailed Description

The Langlade County Highway Department is planning on replacing the CTH H bridge over the Prairie River in the Town of Parrish. This provides an opportunity to greatly improve the trail and safety of this crossing for Snowmobile and Winter ATV use. Currently the snowmobile/ winter ATV trail is utilizing the existing highway bridge to cross the Prairie River. The angel of the access to the bridge relative to the road make visibility difficult when making the crossing. The addition of the recreational wing will separate vehicle traffic and recreational traffic at this location and will allow for a groomed surface on the crossing.

All permitting is to be handled by and at the cost of the Highway Department.

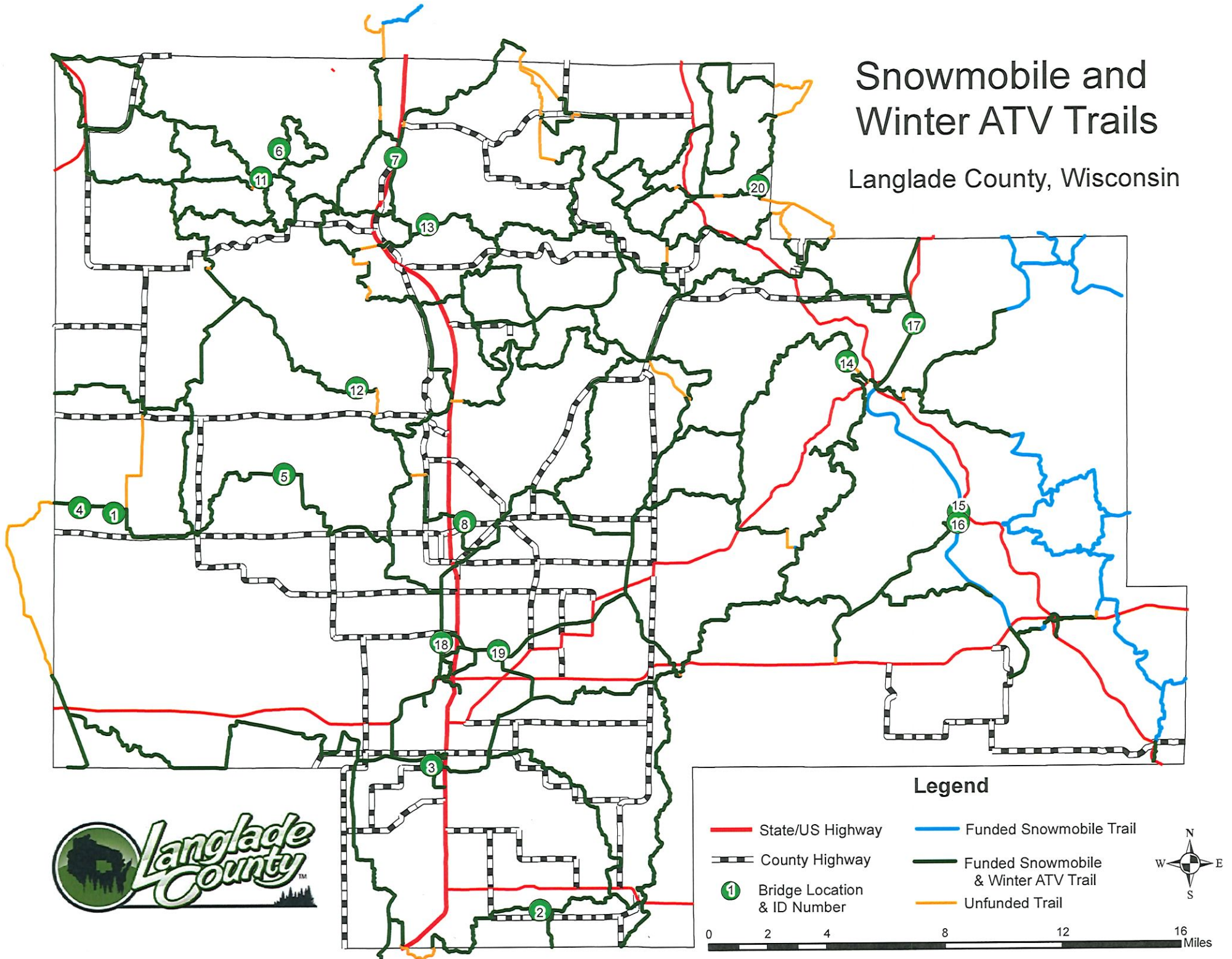

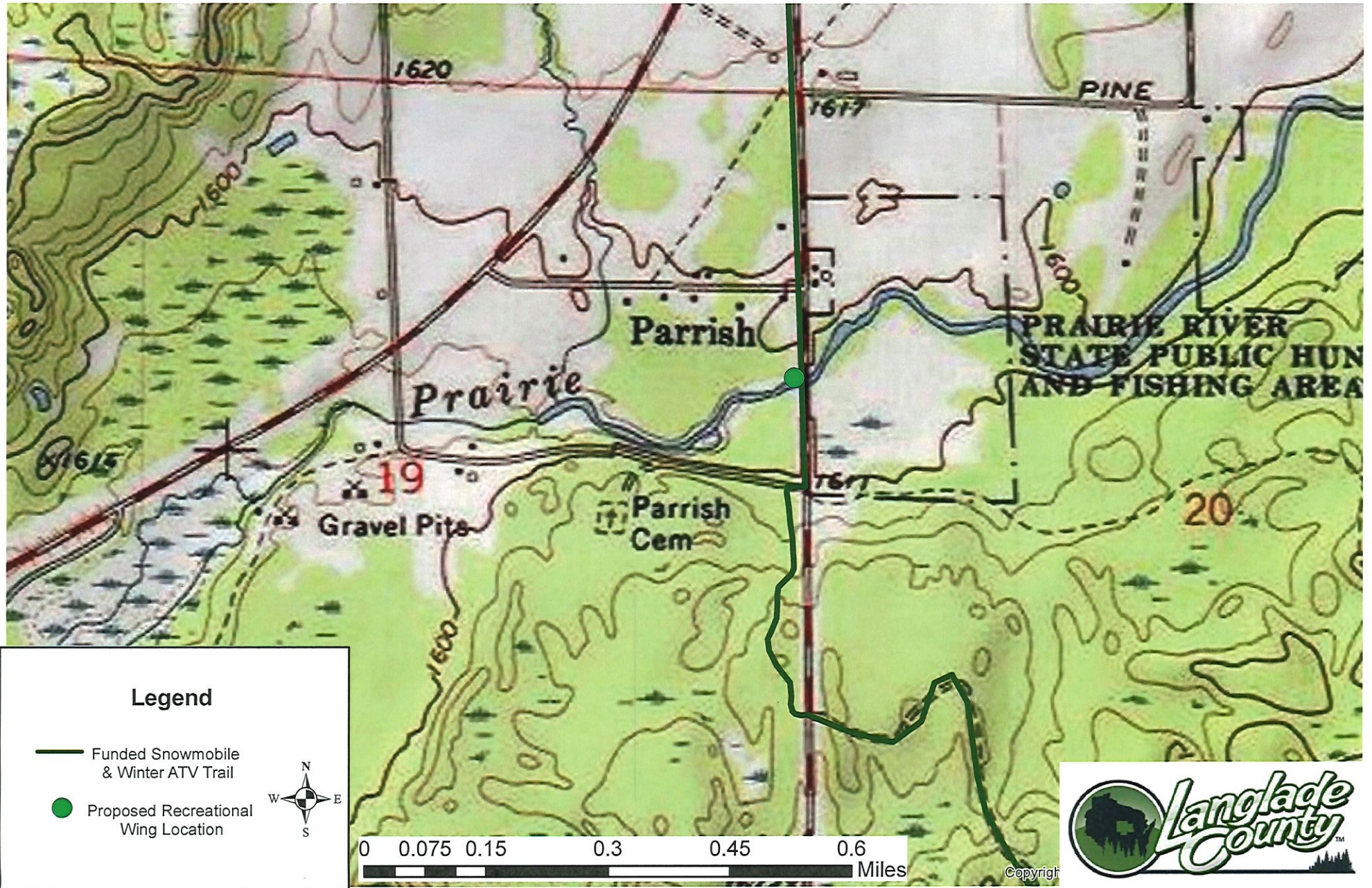

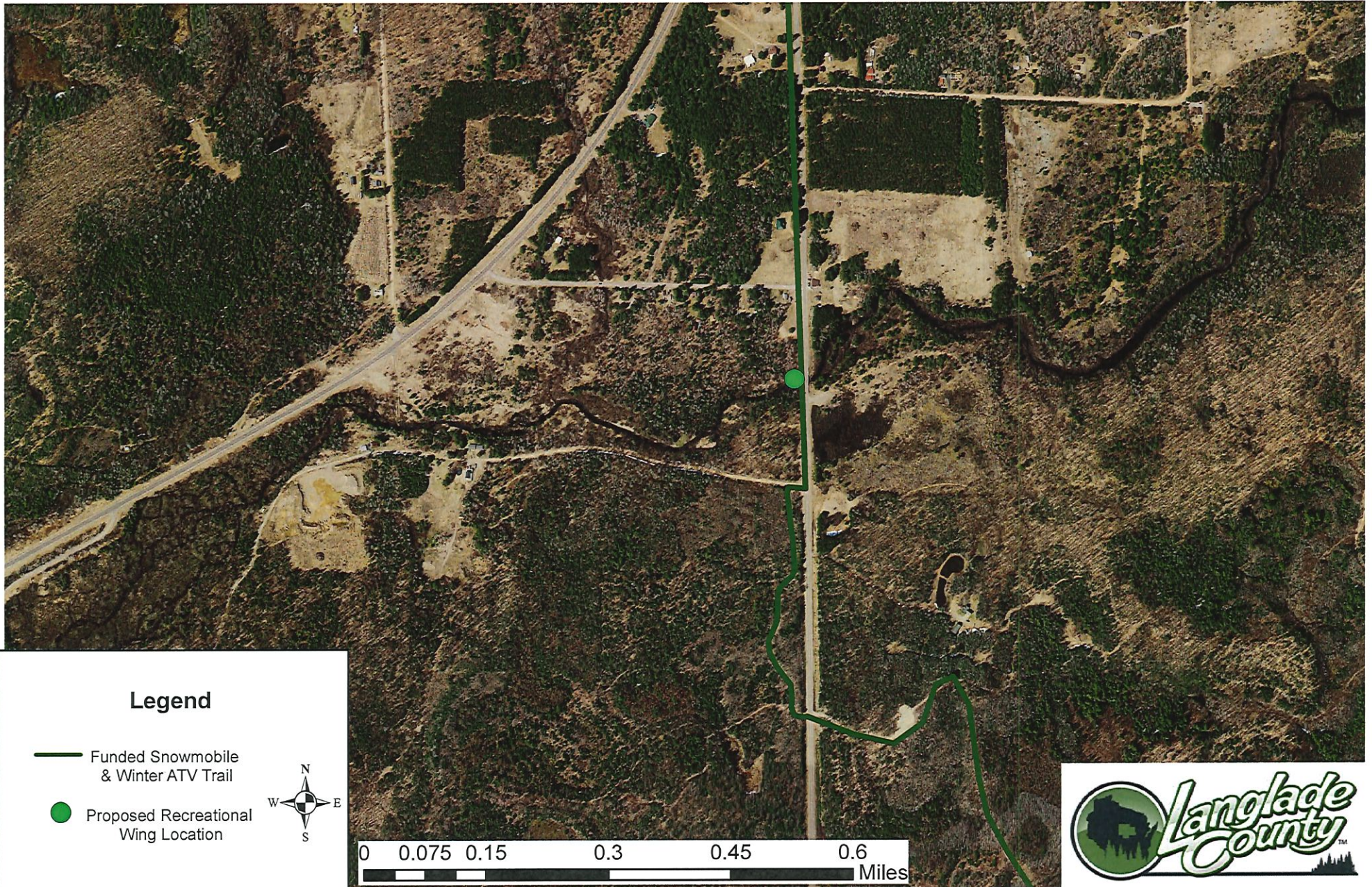
County Highway H Recreational Wing

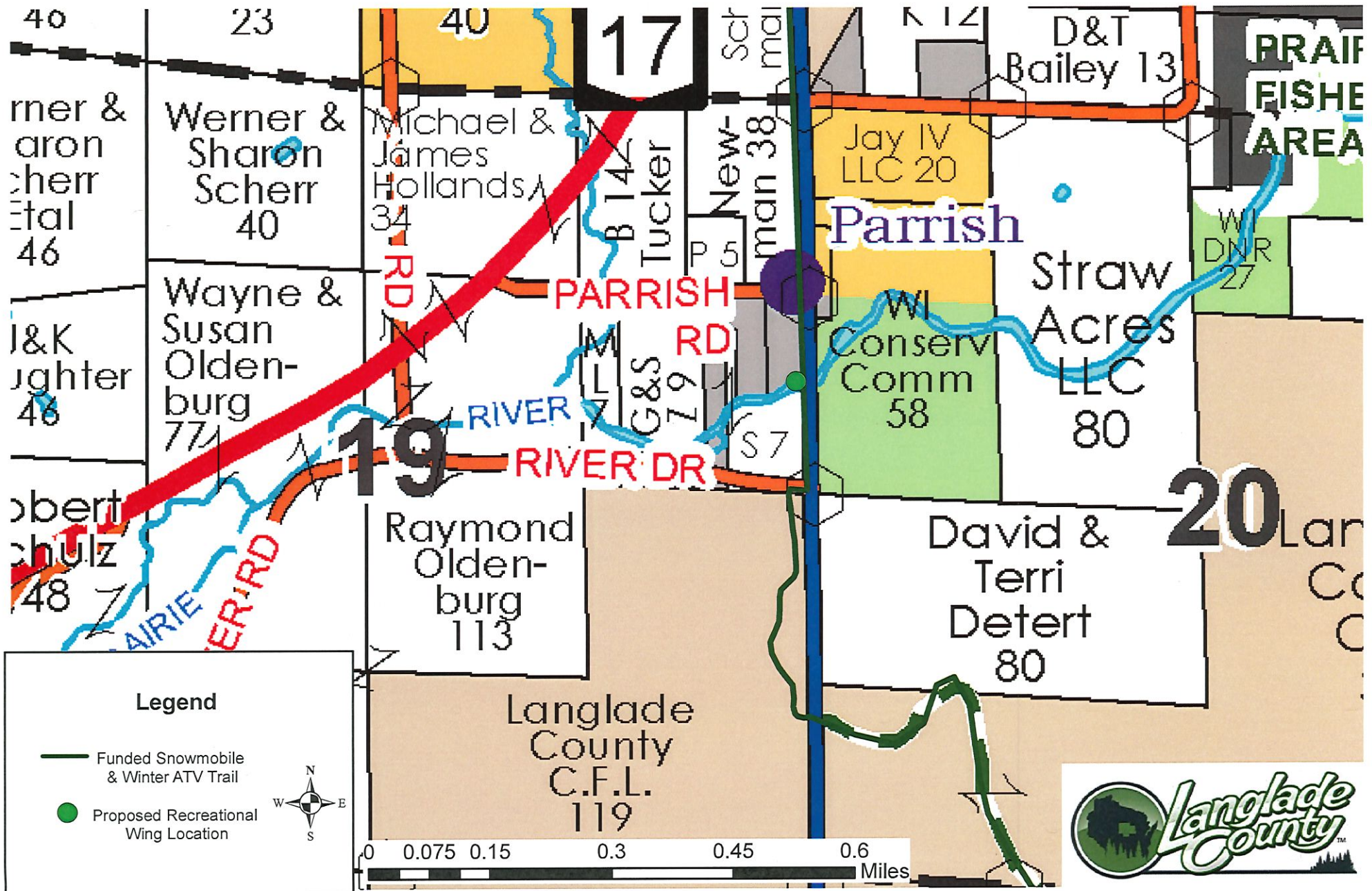

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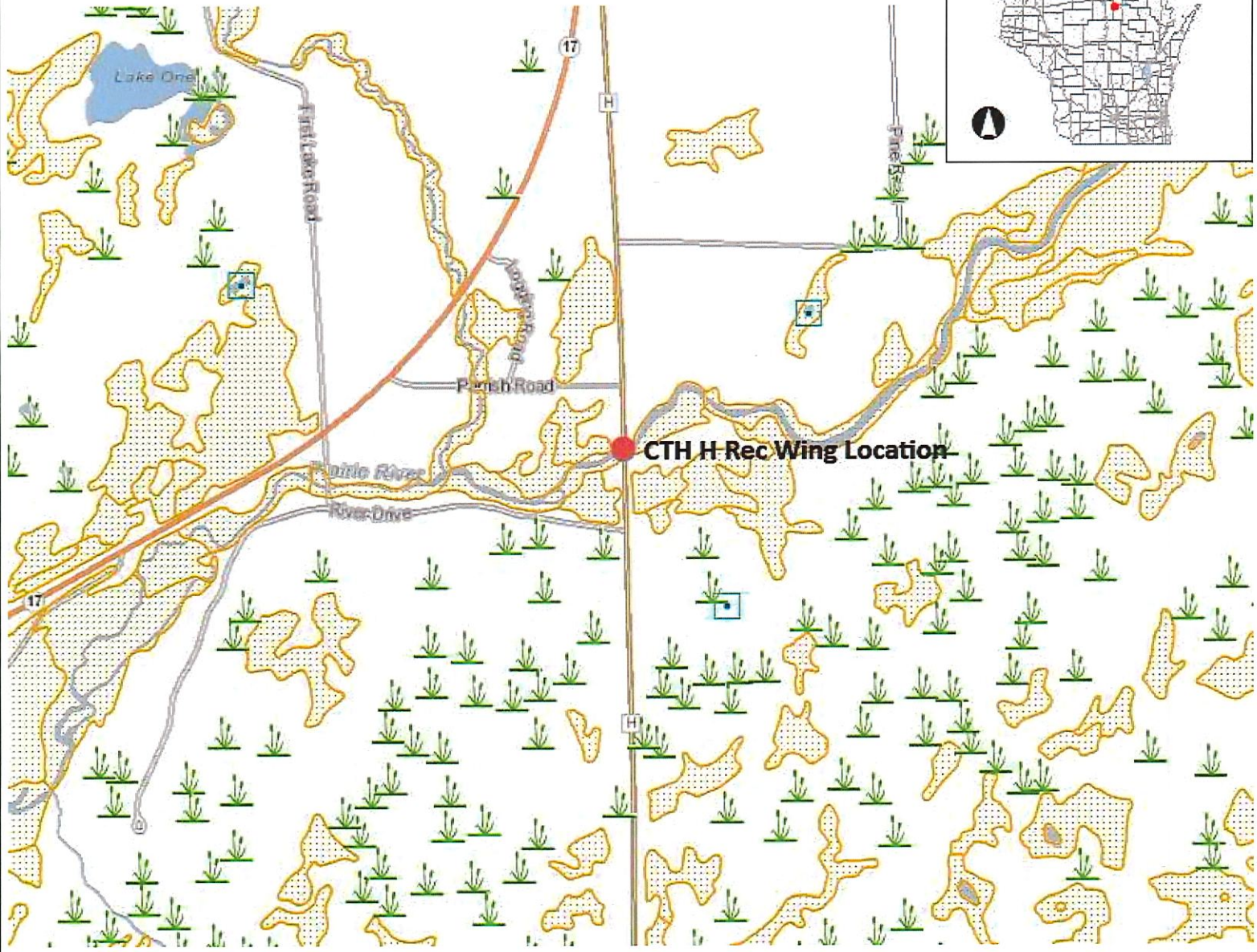

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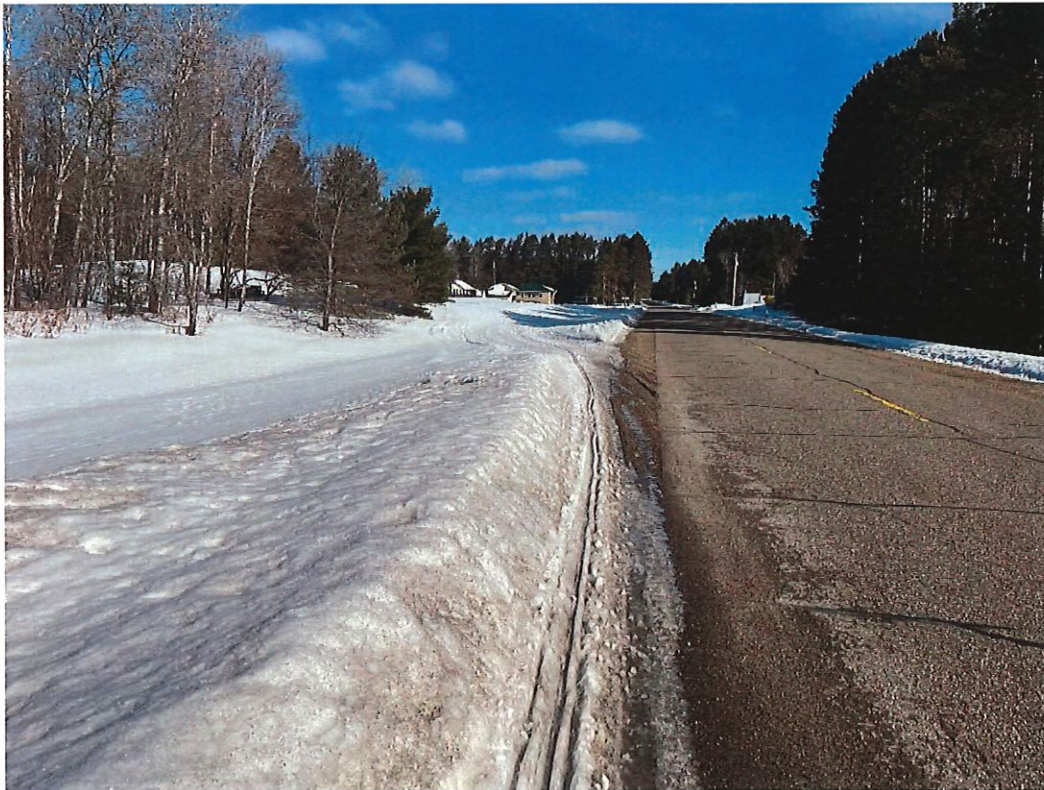
