Vilas County is proposing to Rehab 3.2 miles of funded Summer ATV/UTV Trail know as the Whiskey Trail. On this Trail, there are several areas of blow sand pockets and several deep holes that fill up with water. The purpose of rehabbing this is to make a safer and more maintainable trail. Sand pockets will be packed with breaker run and topped with 6" of gravel. Holes will be filled with pit run, breaker run and topped with 6" of gravel also. There will be 2 culverts installed in the trail on a portion to allow spring run off waters or, if the creek gets plugged up by beavers again, a place for water to flow to keep the trail from being submerged or washed out. There will be one DOT approved asphalt apron where the trail meets the pavement on Torch Lake Rd. This trail is maintained by the Landover ATV Club.

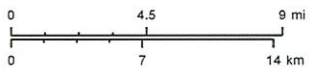

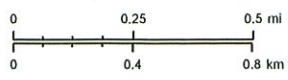

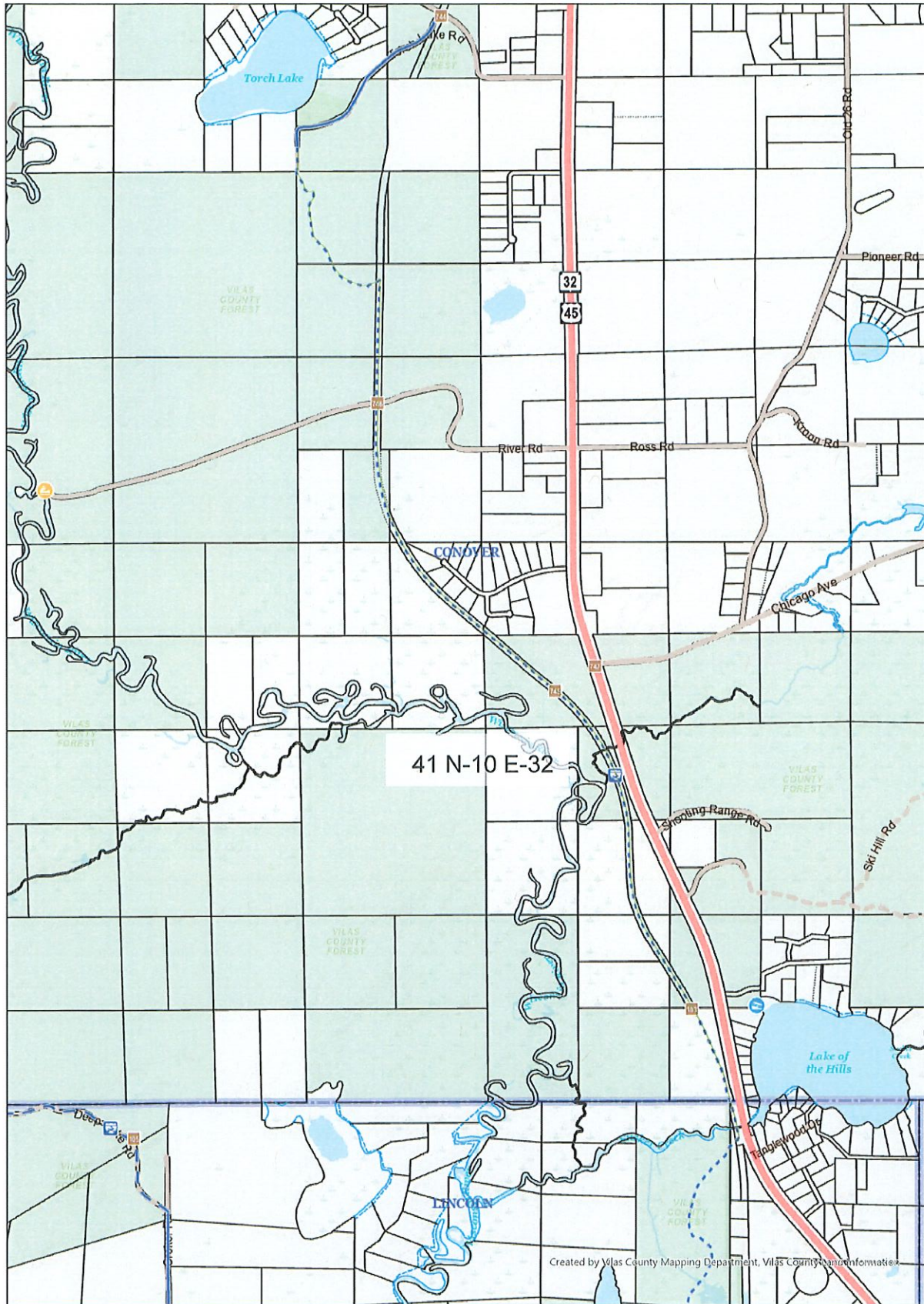

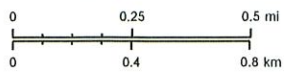

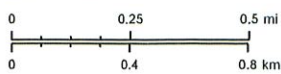
