Project Description Summary

Forest County is looking for Summer and Winter/ year round ATV/ UTV funding and trail maintenance for 5.0 new miles of trails within the "8 mile loop" area". The trail is on Forest County and Potawatomi Tribal Forest Land. This trail would be open for spring, summer, fall and winter. There is a new 5 year-land use contract between ATV Association and Forest County Potawatomi Tribe for use on the trail. This trail would connect the Wolf River State Trail to other trails that would help connect the western part of the county to the east.

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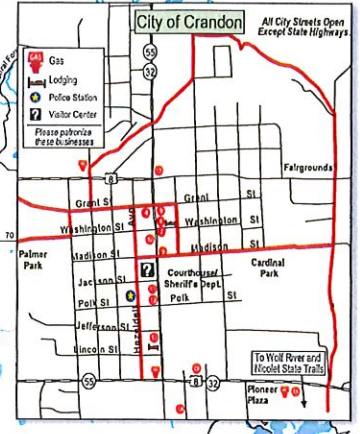
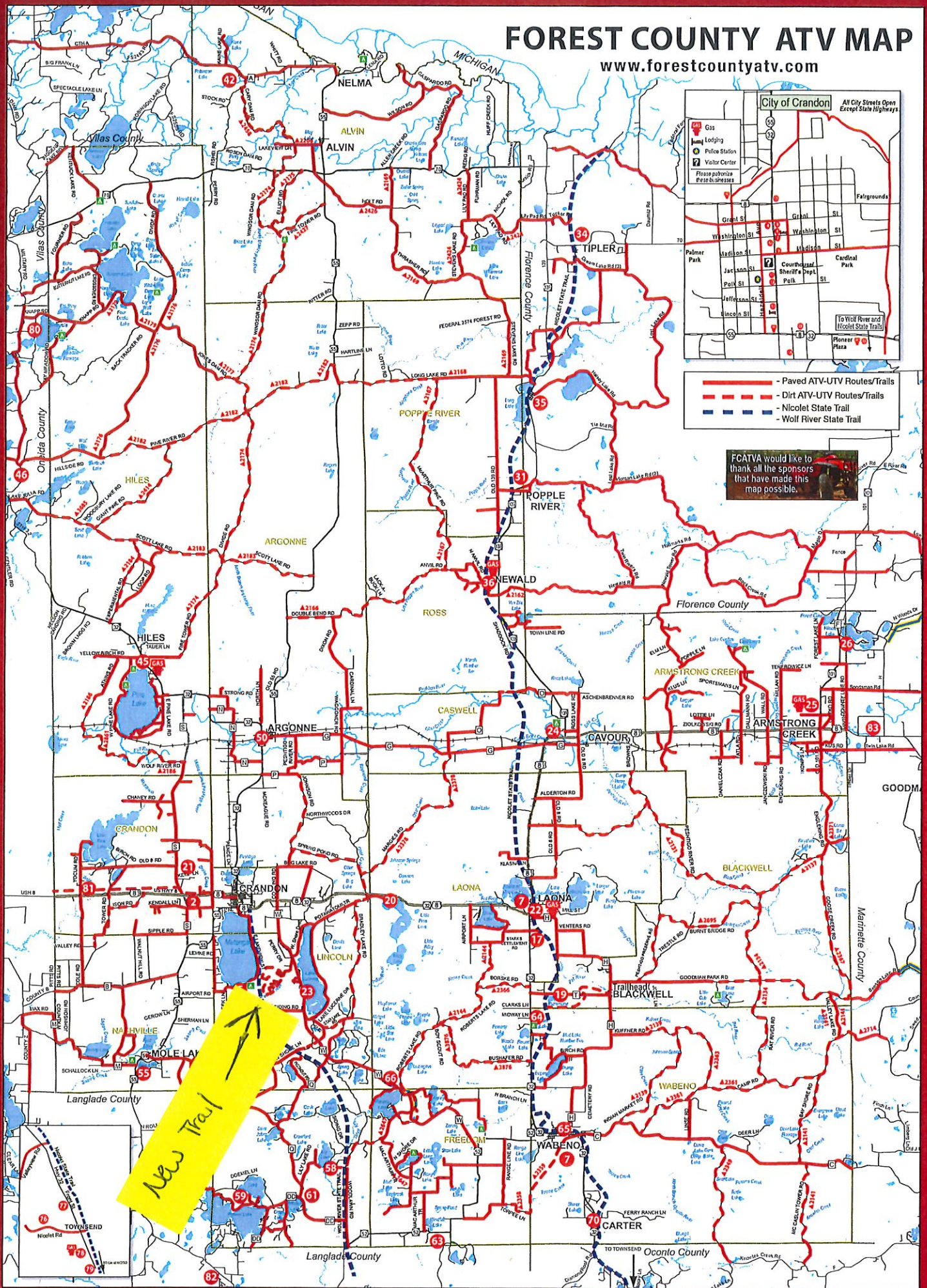

Trail Project Detailed Description
The 5 new miles that Forest County is requesting would connect Wolf River State Trail to the Forest County 8 mile Loop which already has 8 miles of funded atv/utv trails. These are trails that are already developed. 1 mile of the trail would cross Forest County Potawatomi and connect to 8 mile loop on Forest County public land. The other 4 miles are additional miles located in the 8 mile loop to enhance the experience of atv/utv riding experience and spread out the wear. This is a critical section as it will help connect western portion of Forest County to the eastern portion of Forest County. It will create easier travel for riders and limit the amount of riders of County Highways. Forest county ATV Association has a land use agreement with Forest County Potawatomi for 5 years and use to be only ATV/UTV on there segment. This would be a year round use trail.

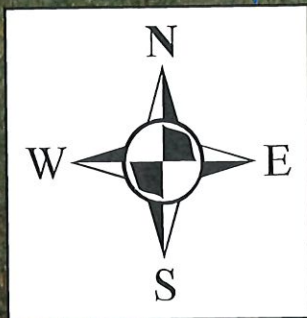

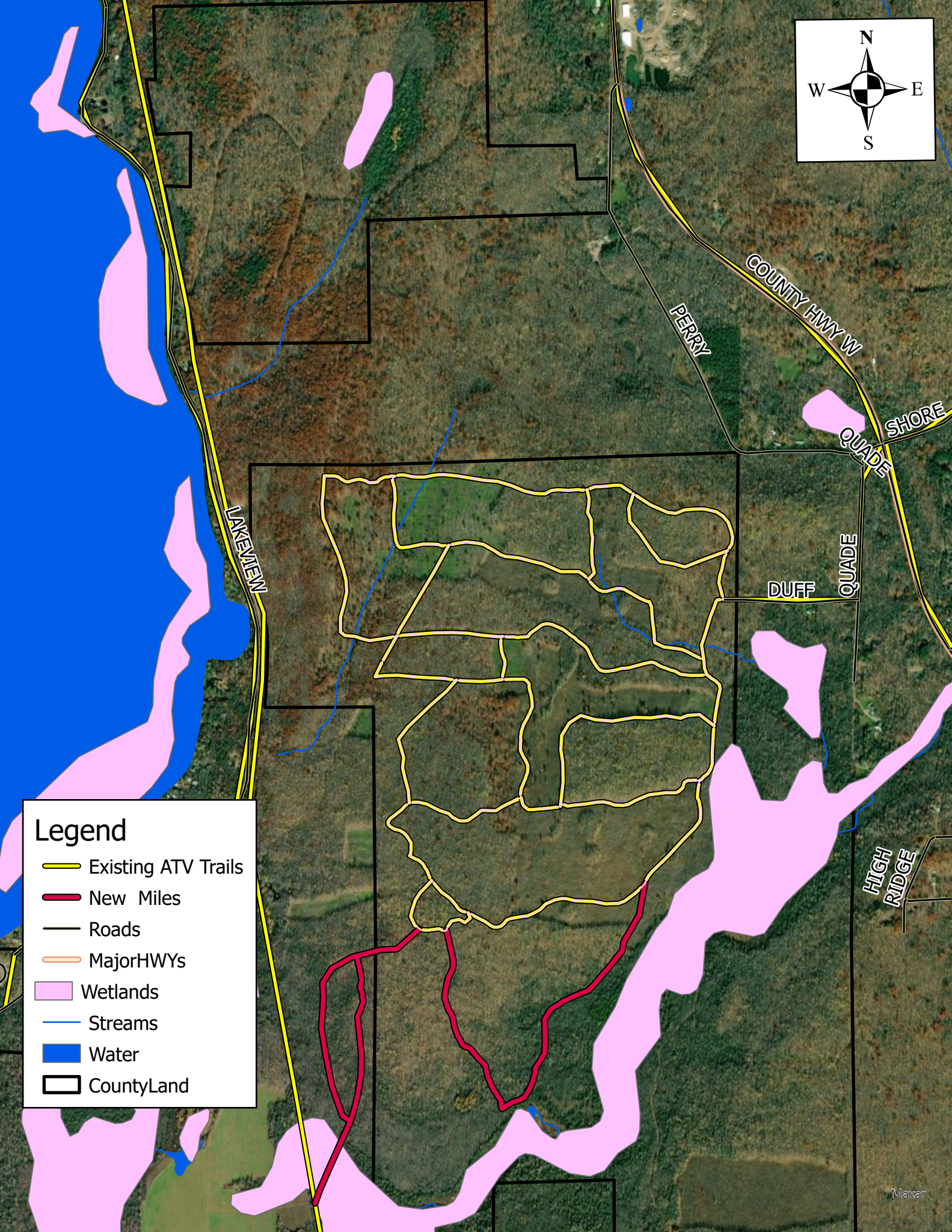

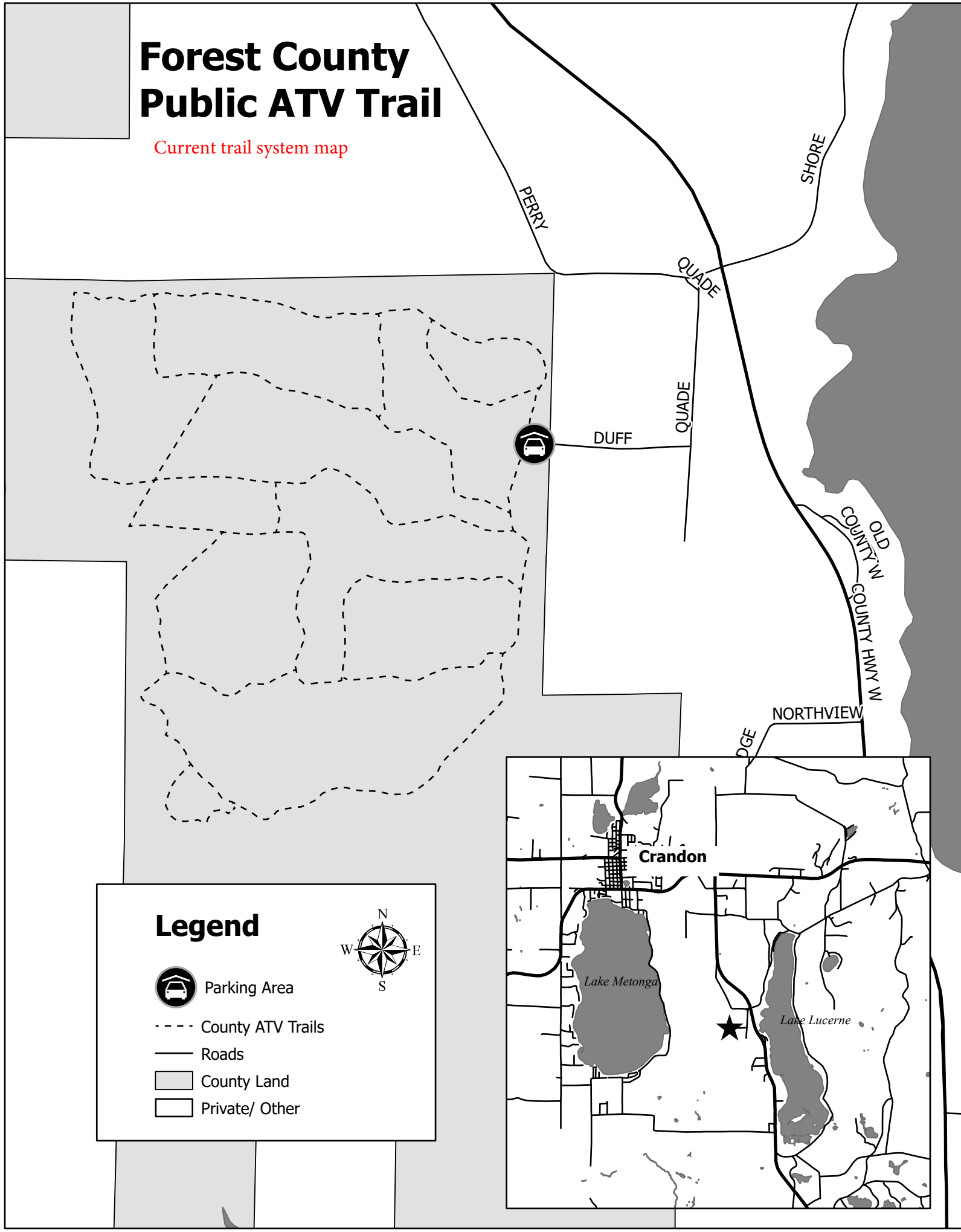
