

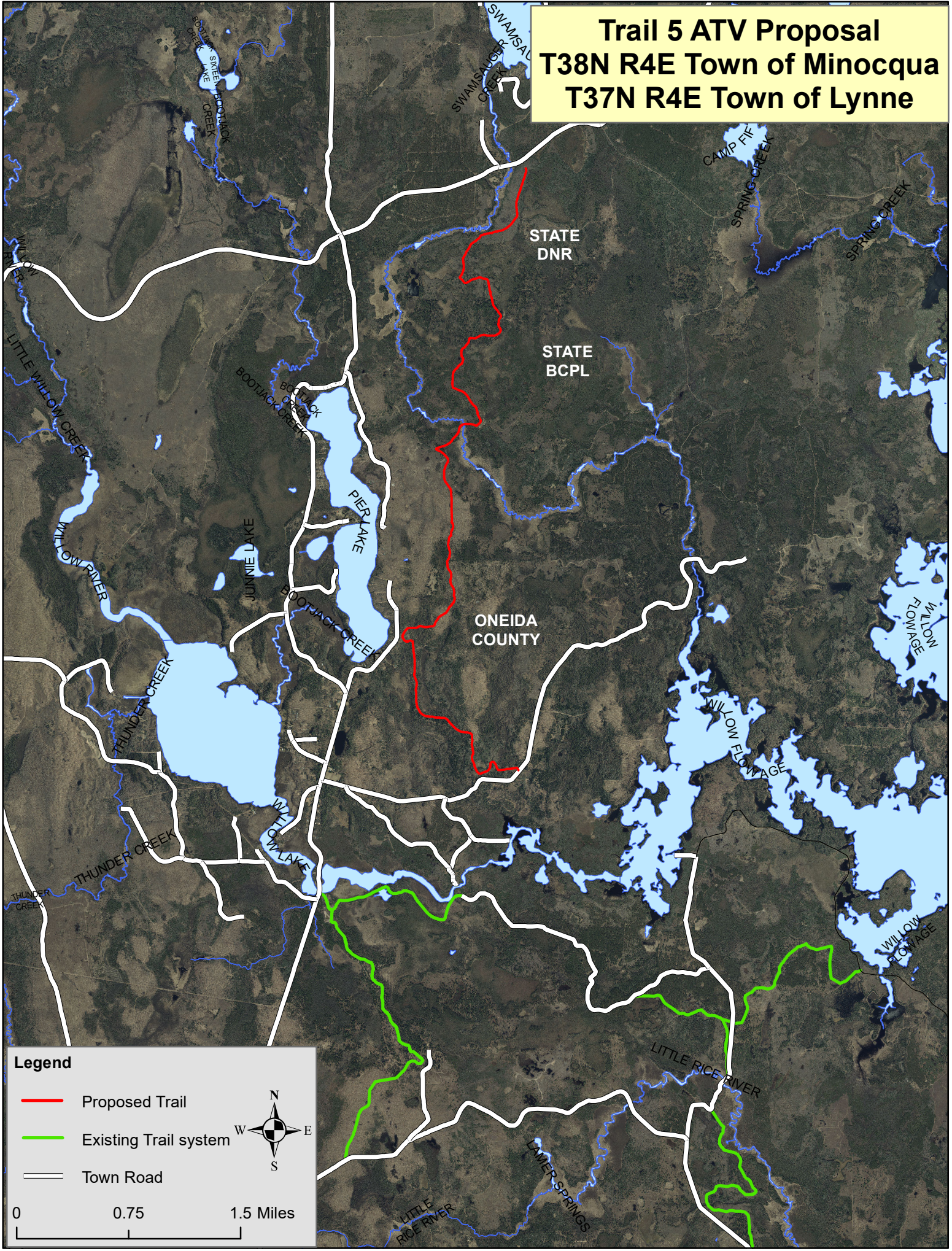
Trail 5 ATV Development

The Oneida County Forestry Department along with the Oneida County ATV Council would like to apply for a grant to develop approximately 6.0 miles of new ATV trail in the Towns of Lynne and Minocqua. This new segment will be entirely on public land and will tie in with the current Little Rice ATV trail system in Oneida County. This new ATV trail will be on the current snowmobile Trail 5, which is a funded snowmobile trail. It will be open for ATV/UTV use in Spring, Summer, Fall seasons and snowmobile only in Winter.

The objective is to bring the trail up to a standard that will be suitable for the heavy ATV/UTV traffic in this area of the county. The trail will be brought up to grade and gravel will be placed where necessary along the trail. No bridges are needed, however the existing culverts at Swampsauger Creek will be removed and replaced with larger culverts to help prevent flooding and washout issues. The Lakeland ATV Club has already donated \$30,000 to this project to cover the cost of initial engineering. The engineering firm has submitted all necessary documents for permits and will have a construction blueprint drafted by mid-summer. The engineering cost associated with this grant will be for construction oversight. This trail will eliminate 5.5 miles of blacktop road route. There is an existing parking lot on DNR property on the north end of the trail.

Oneida County is an audited and certified county through the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) and Forest Stewardship Council (FSC). The SFI and FSC standards include forest roads and motorized recreational trails that must adhere to BMP's and protect water quality. These standards address the layout, construction and maintenance of roads, recreational trails and skid trails to protect waters to make sure the quality of the roads and surrounding areas are sustainable and degraded.

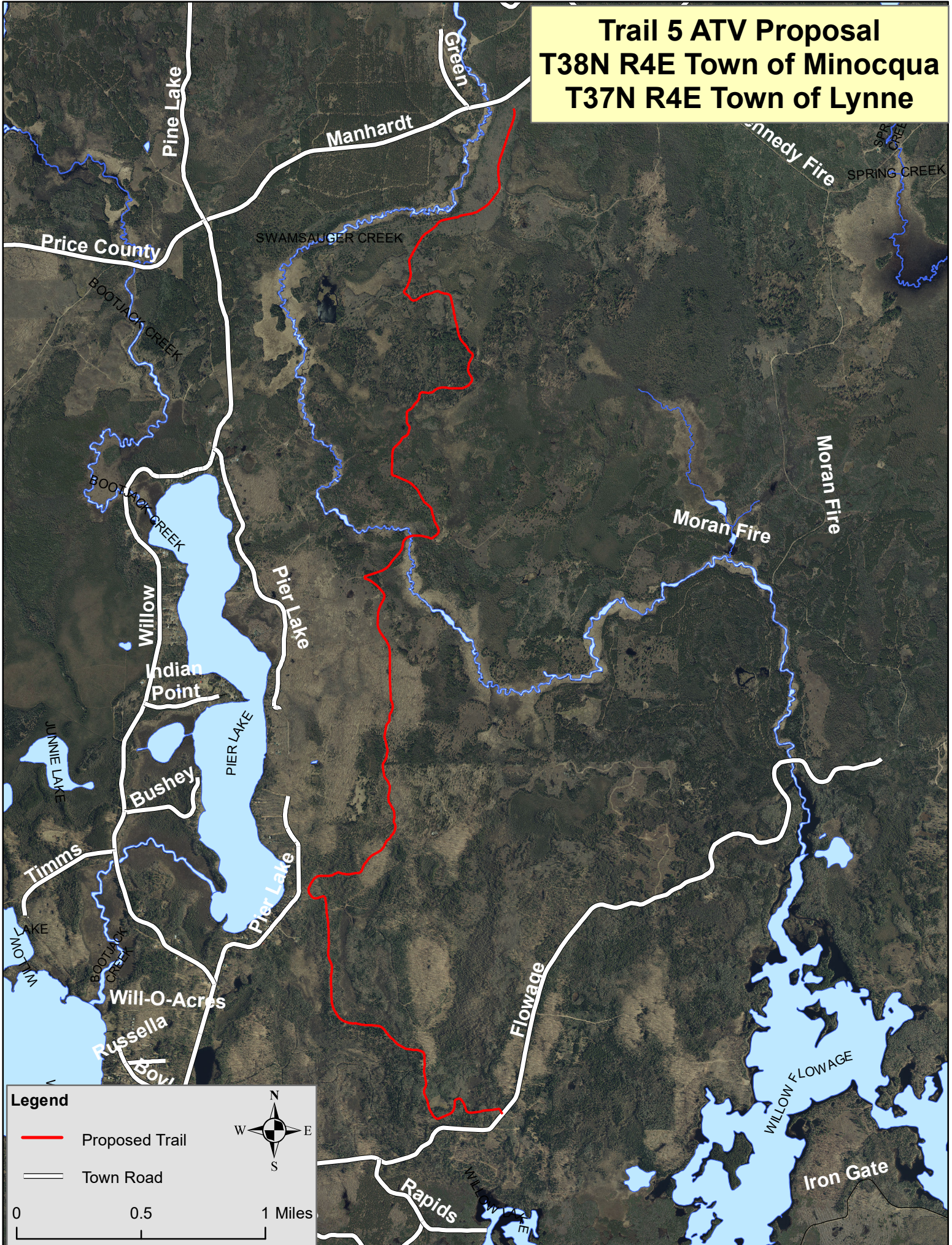

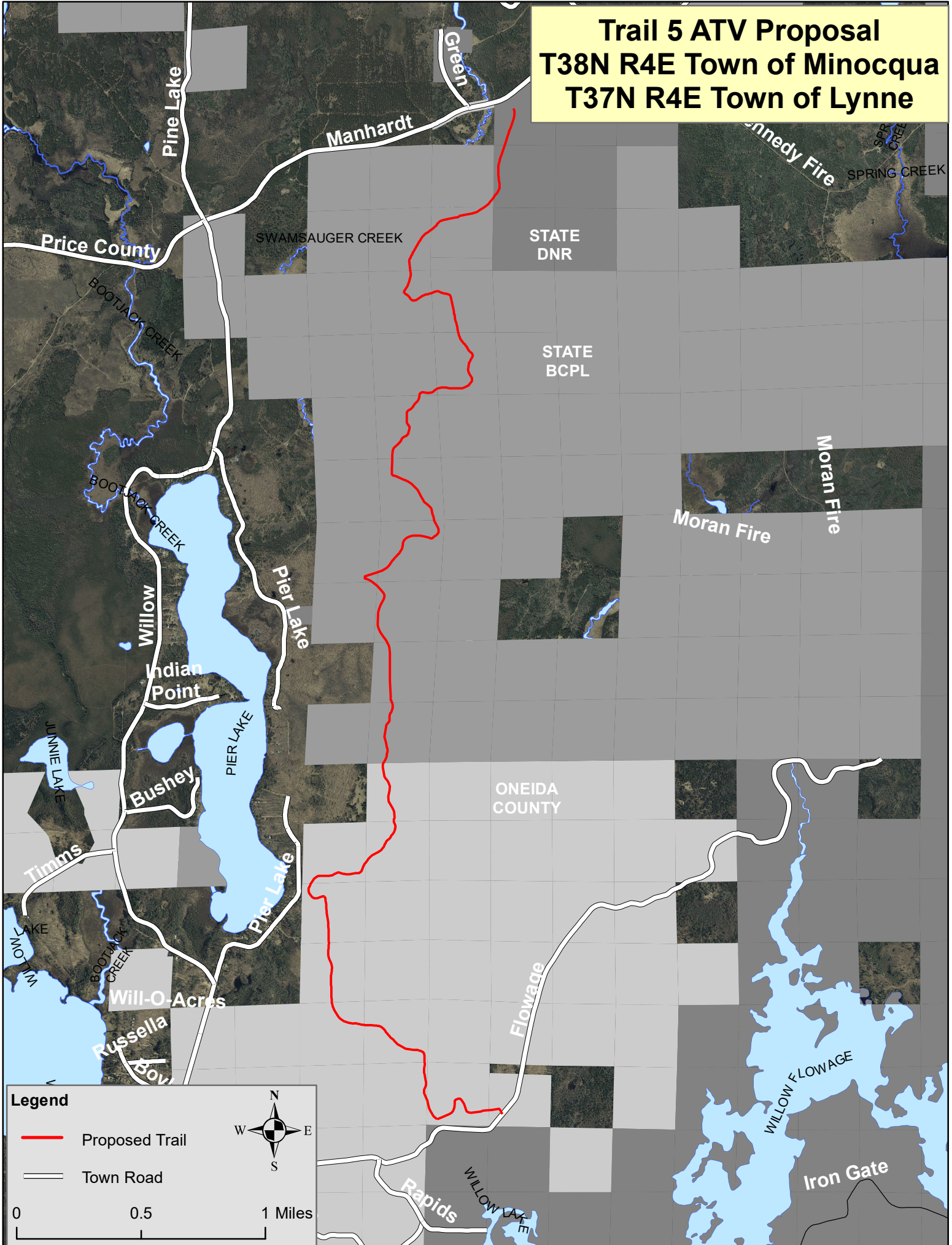

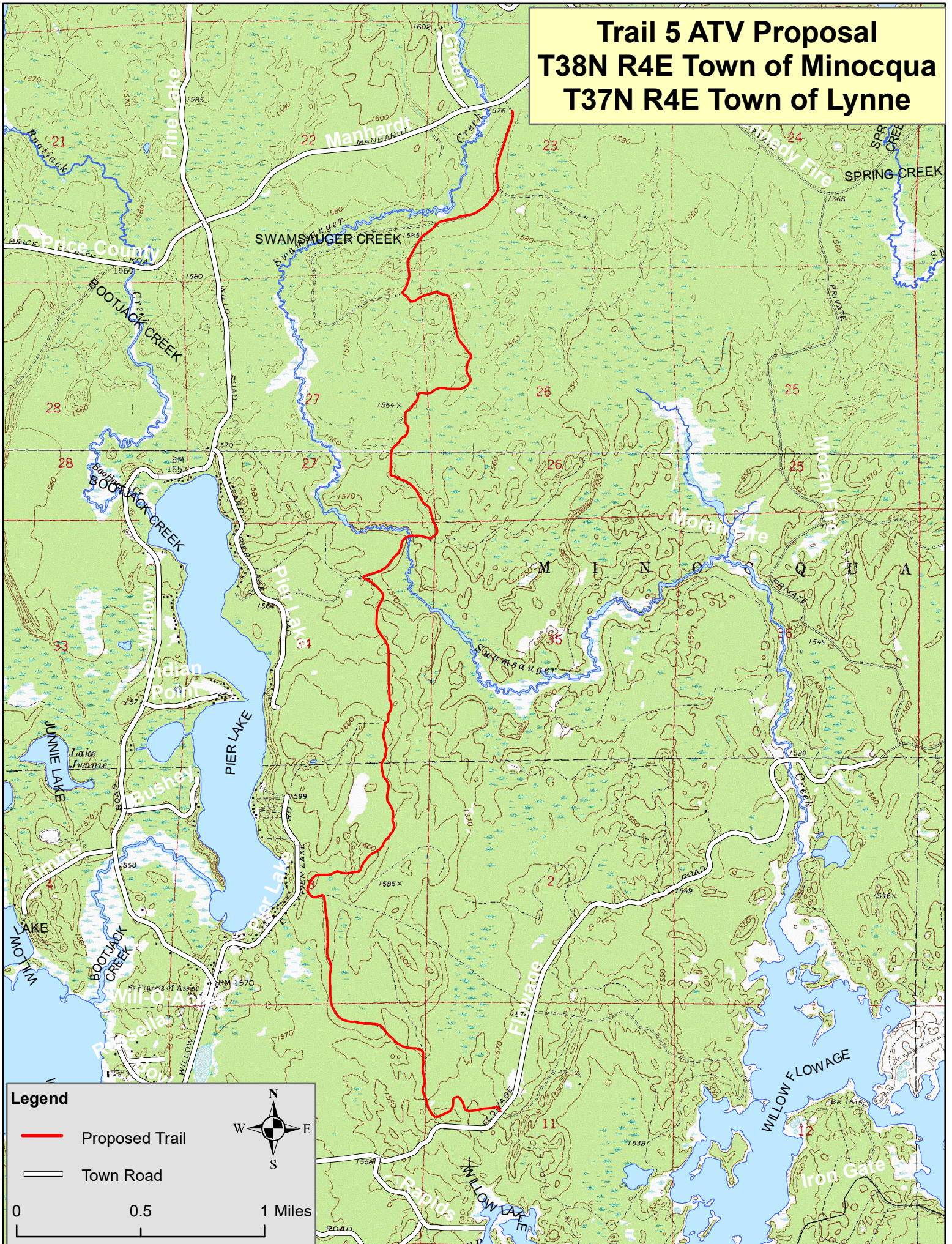

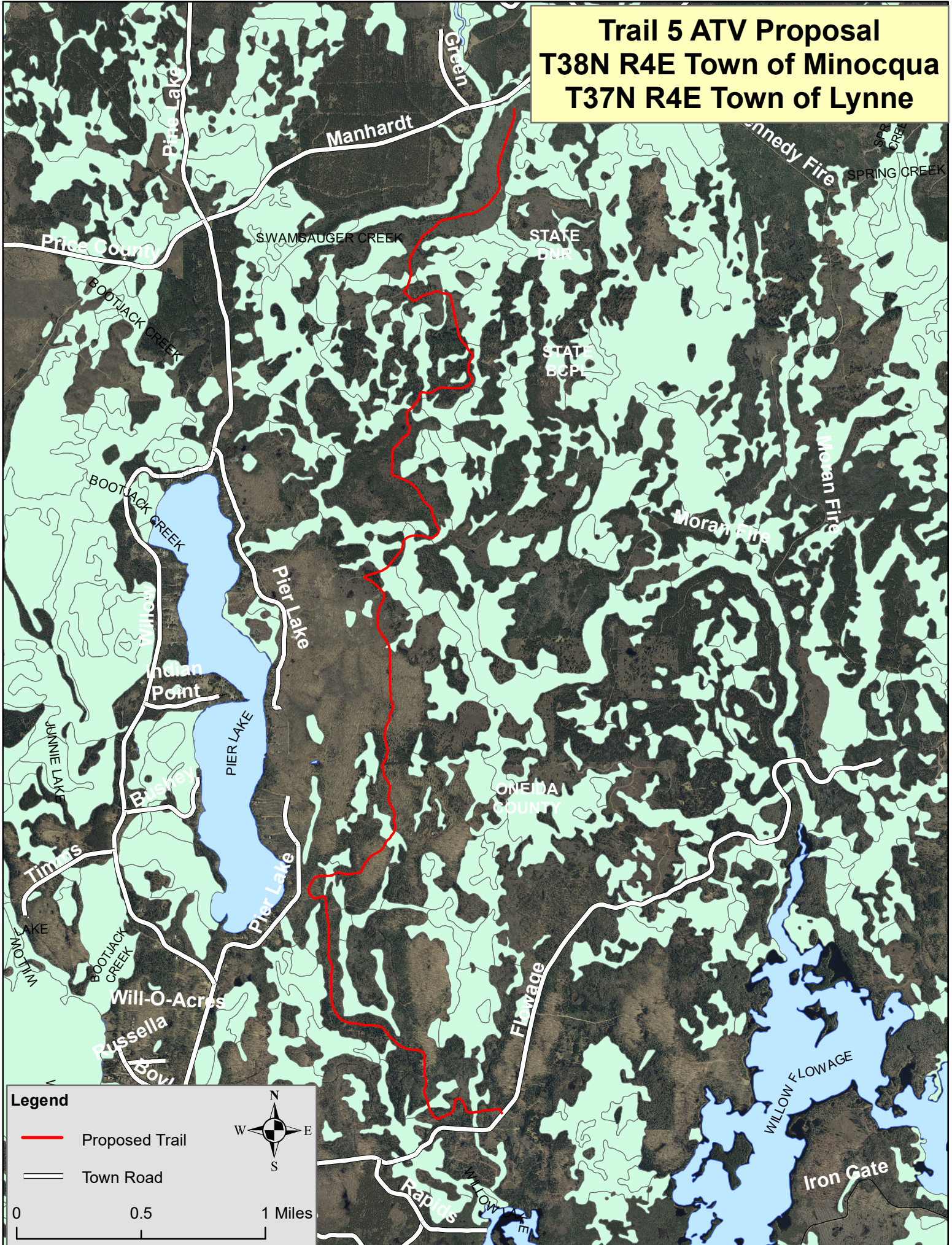
