Project Description Summary

Upgrade sites to electrical sites that are currently non electrical sites they are located in our ATV section of East Arbutus Campground in Hatfield WI. The occupancy rate of these sites has fallen to 1.5 days a week. East Arbutus ATV Electrical addition

Project Overview

The work would take place at our East Arbutus Campground located in Hatfield Wisconsin that is along the ATV trail that connects Jackson and Clark County's trail systems. The trail system has grown along with the desire of more park accommodations. Electrical has always been a request of the park visitors with our ATV Electrical sites being filled every weekend and has an occupancy of 3.2 day per week. While our non-electric sites have an occupancy rate of 1.5 days a week. This request would help fill the requests of the visitors of the trails staying in our area. The developing area is located between two showerhouse facilities and is good flat ground.



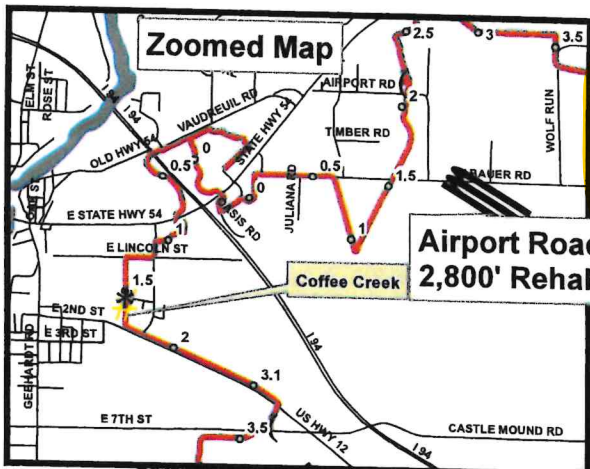
We would take a portion of our non-electric group ATV sites and redesign the layout of those sites to accommodate single occupancy with 50amp electrical sites. The total number of sites would change from 8 to 12 in this area of the park. The sites would stay on the larger side with a minimum width of 60 feet to accommodate the larger campers as many campers are bringing toy haulers and multiple vehicles while camping.

The county would purchase the needed 50-amp electrical pedestals and underground wire to complete the job and contract out the trenching, installation of the pedestals and installation of the CT cabinet. We would also have to replace/ upgrade our electrical service provided equipment from our cooperative and it will require an additional electrical meter to the location. Each site would receive approximately two loads of gravel to be smoothed out to form a parking pad and fill any low areas on the site. Tables would be metal frame with wood tops and grills would be steel with cooking grates.

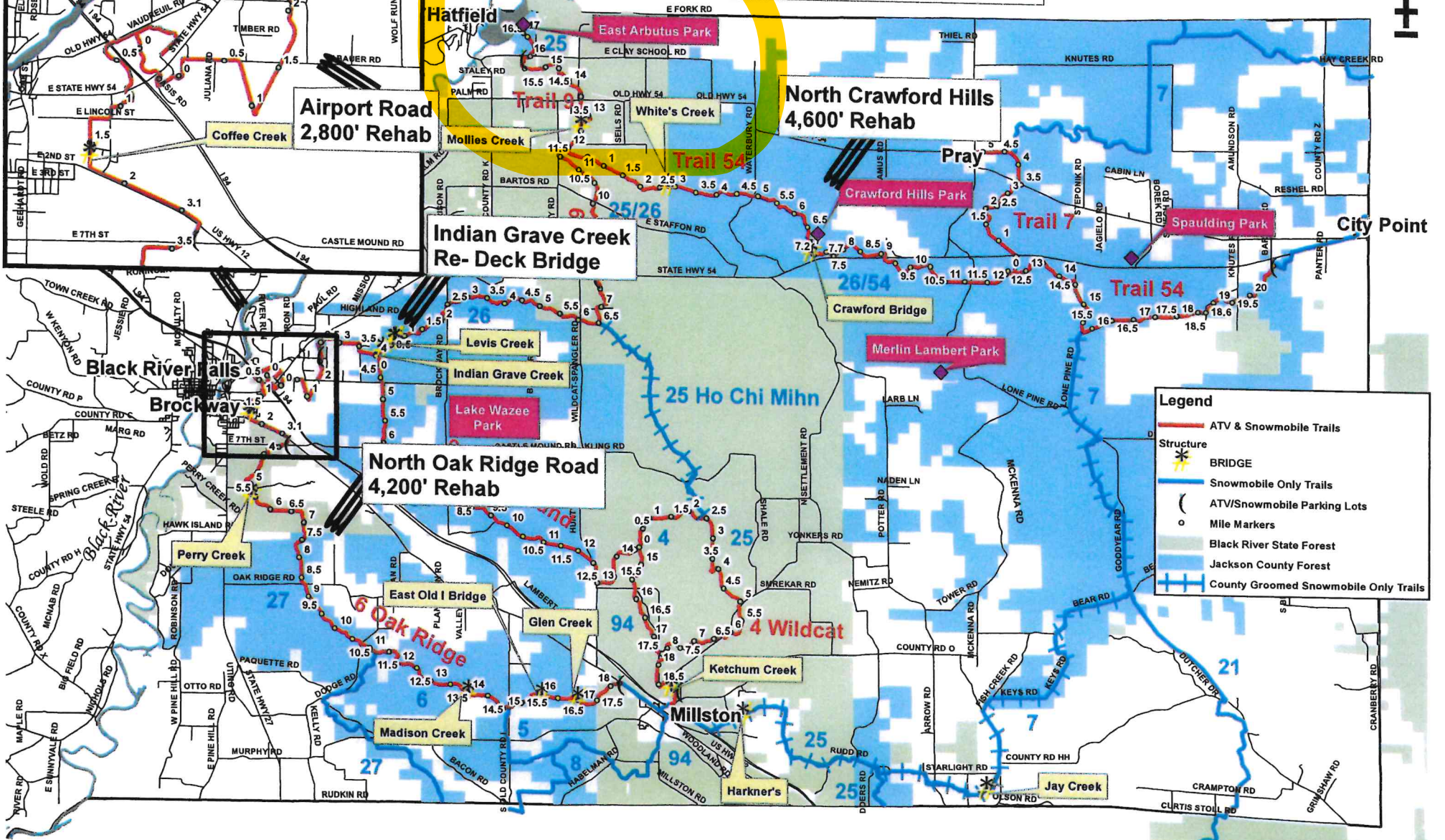
Potential upgraded site location







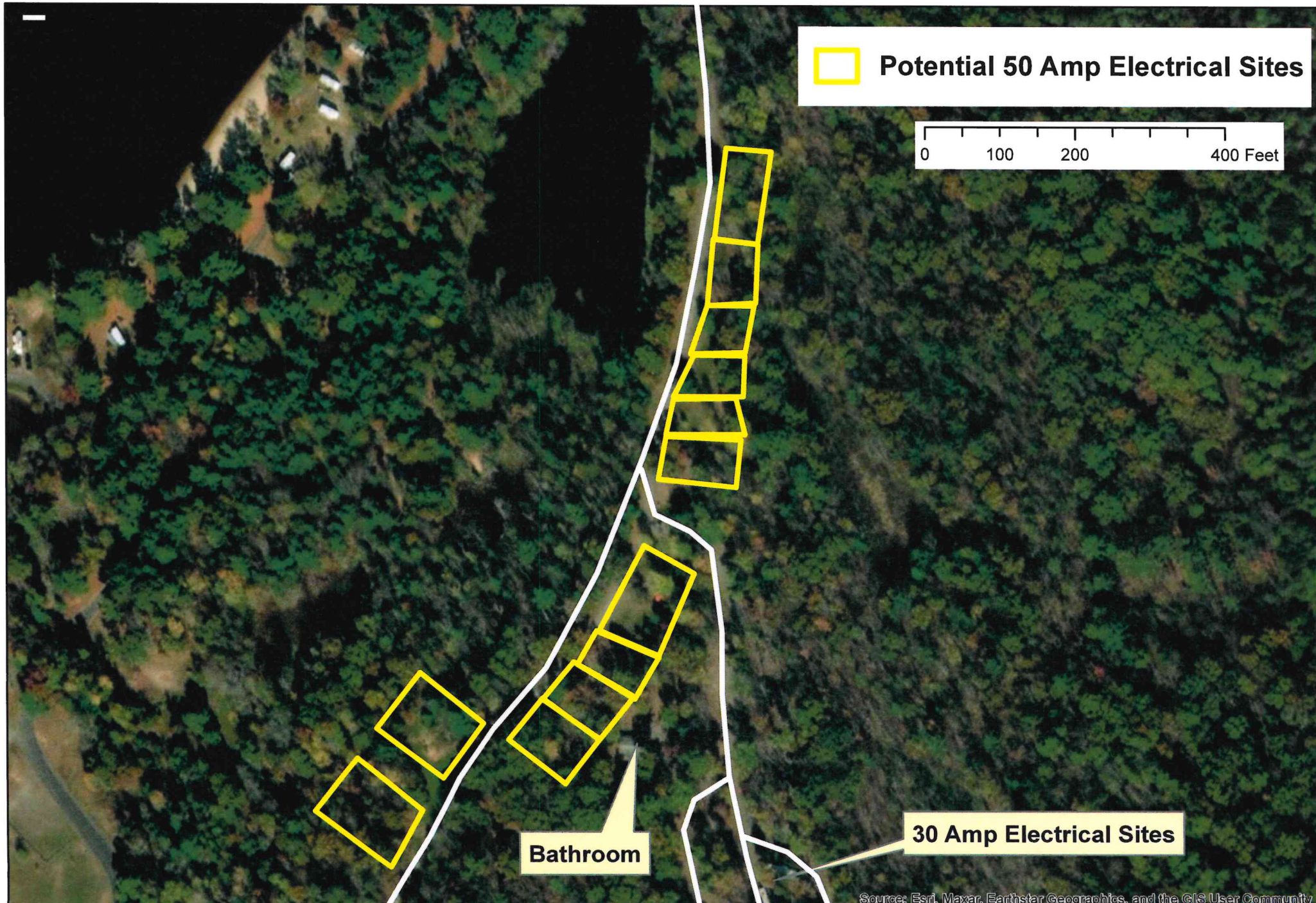

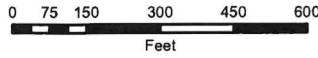
