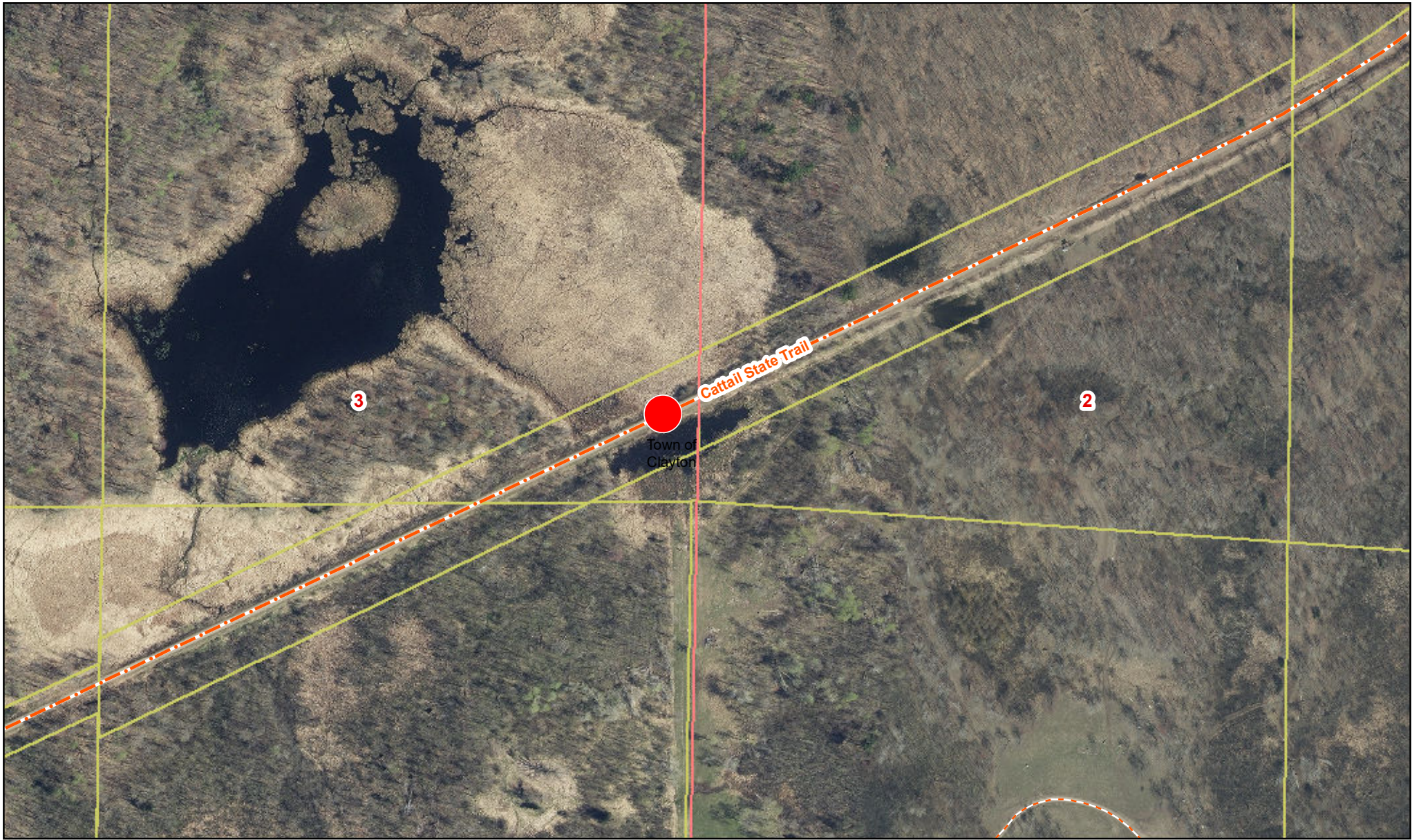

Cattail State Trail - Washout Area

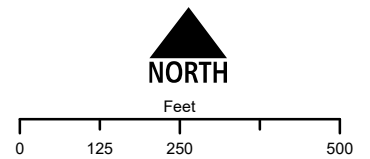

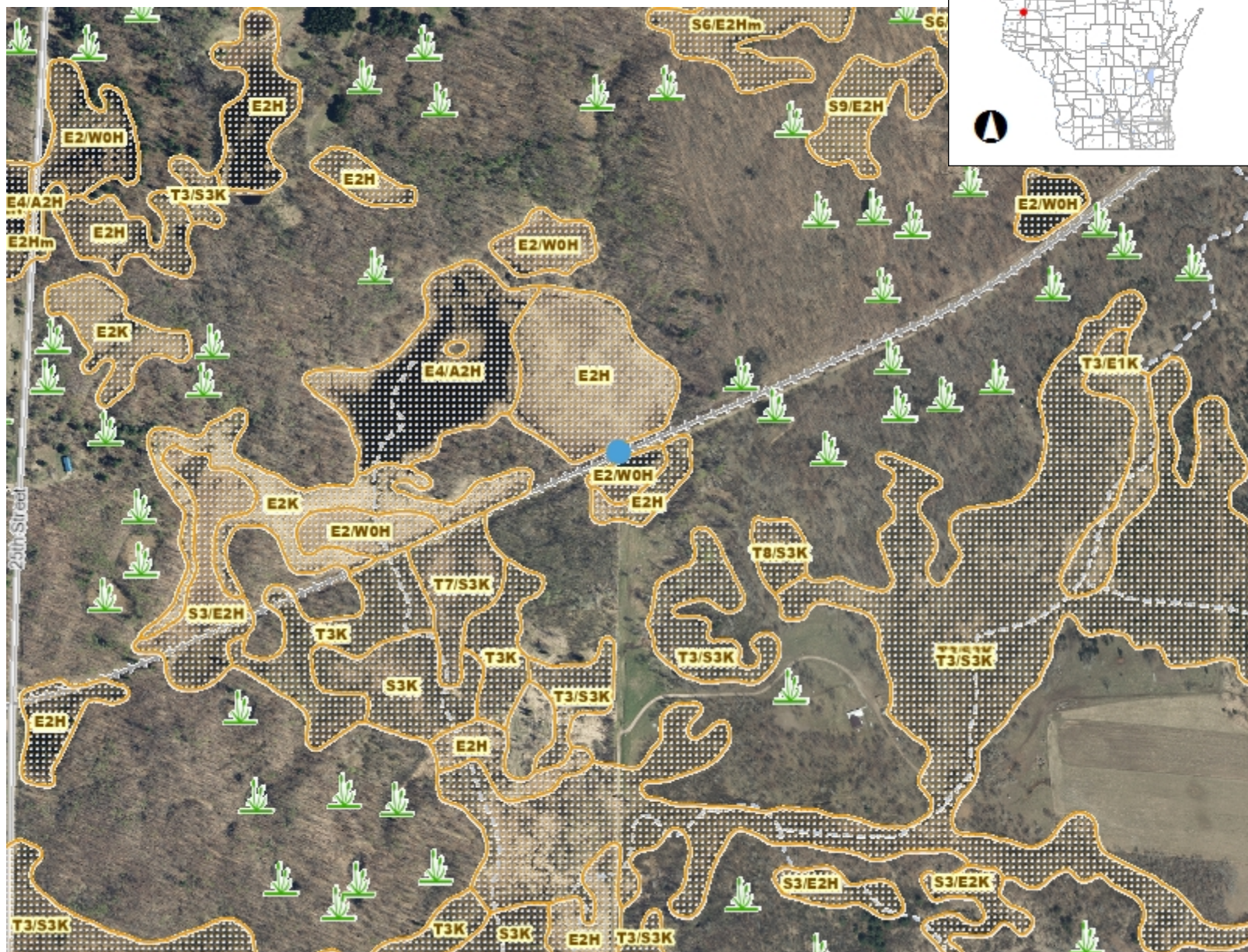

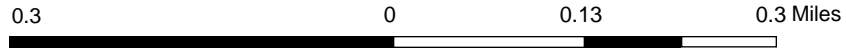
