Project Description Summary

The Taylor County Forestry and Recreation Department proposes to rehabilitate approximately 155 miles of funded snowmobile trails known as the Taylor County Snowmobile Trails. Department staff and club members have performed reconnaissance on the trail system for required cleanup work resulting from the December 13th, 2022 ice/snow storm. While these trails were open for the 2022-2023 snowmobile season they do require additional work to restore them to pre-storm conditions, ensuring a safe and enjoyable riding experience for our users. Initial cleanup effort cost was \$220/mile. The estimated cost to for final cleanup is approximately 25% of the initial cleanup effort or approximately \$55/mile. Cleanup will include snowmobile club members/equipment, county staff/equipment, and contractors. Primary equipment to be used will include chainsaw, pole saw, skid steer with various attachments, excavator with various attachments, and bull dozer.



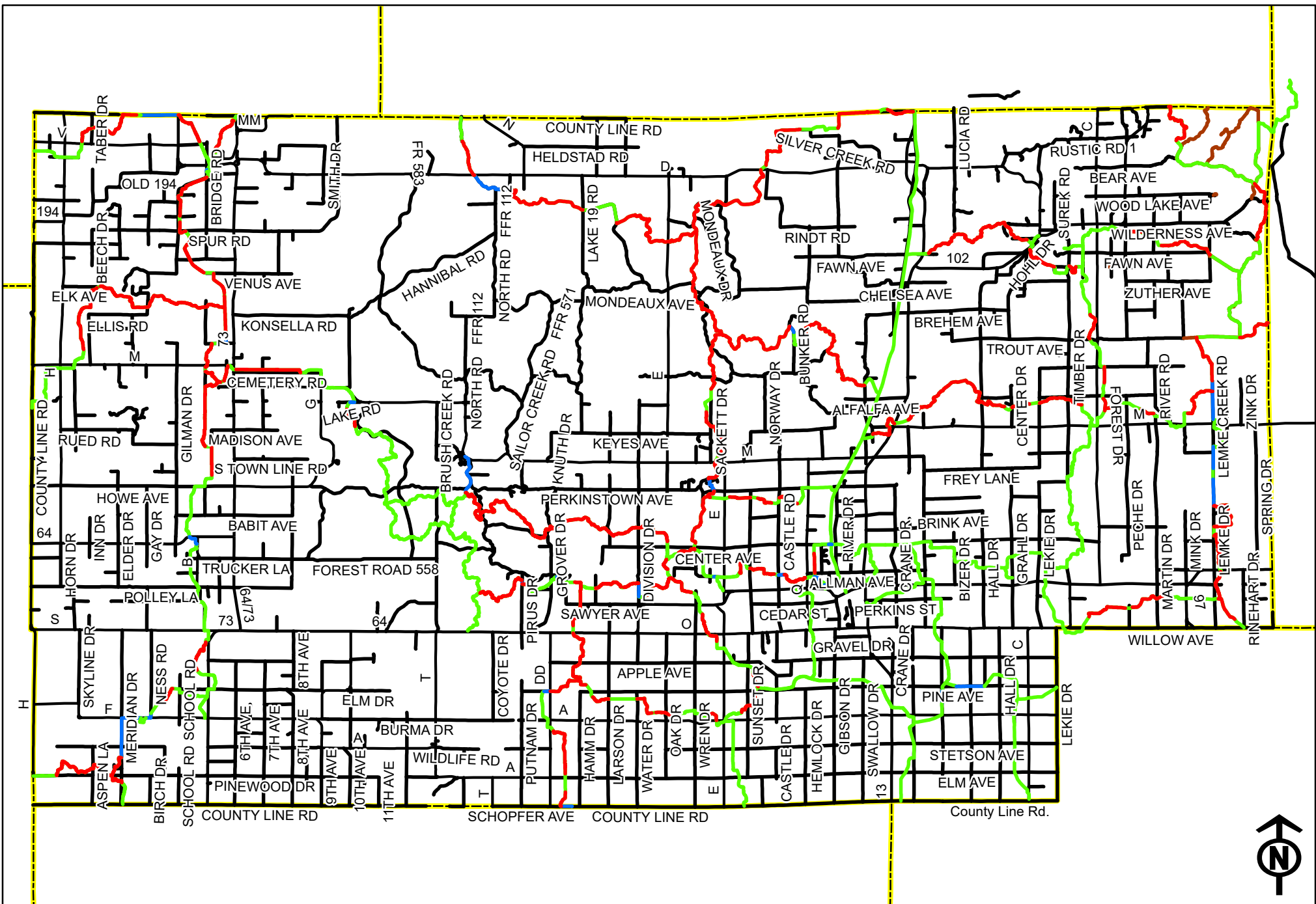
