
## What is the Permit Process for Wetlands?



DNR reviews your Supply the missing/incorrect information within 14 days. application for completeness and correct information **Review Timelines** - 45 days for permits in the Ceded Territory, or wild rice waters. - 30 days for permits with large scale effects. - 21 days for all other permits. **DNR** reviews Permit holder posts two signs at all public access points and denies or issues your with a link to the permit and plan, a control map, and permit. Permit holders may write to request an amendment to the approved permit for: - The company managing the control **DNR** reviews - The individual conducting the control and denies or approves - The control area (if the area is within the scope of the your request to amend the approved plan) permit. - The disposal site for removed aquatic plants - The finalized monitoring data - The trade name of a herbicide

If the DNR requests a supervision on the permit cover letter, notify them 4 business days in advance of the first control.

Permit holder conducts control, then submits a control report summarizing the last month's work. This should be submitted every 30 days.

Years 2-5

- Pay fee (1/2 first year)
- Post public access points
- Submit control reports

Permits Expire December 31st of Year 5.

Re-apply for a control permit again in year 6.

DNR may supervise the control event(s)
