

Septage Vehicle Requirements

Revised 07/13/2023 SSW



IMPORTANT NOTE: *The following requirements also apply to portable restrooms vehicles that service septic tanks, holding tanks, grease interceptors, etc.*

Lettering—One Side of Vehicle

Each licensee shall display on at least one side of the septage vehicle the words “*Wisconsin Sanitary Licensee*” and immediately under those words “*License No.* ” with the number of its license.

Important Note: Letters and numbers must be at least 2 inches high, and lettering and numbering must be in distinct color contrast to its background.

Note: Many septage businesses letter both sides of the vehicle to show professionalism to their customers and/or give a “balanced” appearance to their vehicle.



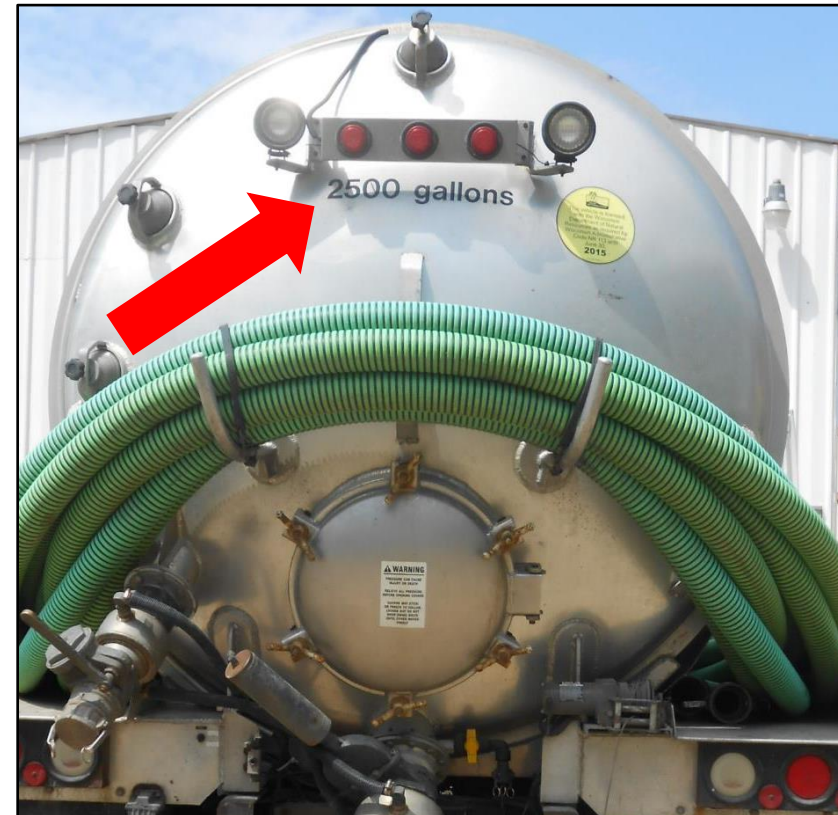

Lettering—Capacity on Back of Vehicle

Each licensee shall display on each vehicle the capacity of the tank in gallons, in lettering and numbers at least 2 inches high in a color distinct from the background.

Important Note: Letters and numbers must be readily visible on the rear of the vehicle. Hoses do not visibly block lettering.

Caution: Lettering displayed shall contrast to their background (example: black letter on silver tank).

Sticker Placement

A valid business license sticker must be prominently displayed on the rear of the vehicle servicing tank.



Caution: Business stickers shall be placed so that hoses do not visually block stickers.
