The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract ends June 30, 2025.

Special Sale Conditions:

In portions of sale, equipment use will be permitted to extremely dry or frozen ground conditions.

No harvest may occur from April 1- June 30 due to bark on residual trees being easily damaged during this time period.

Decking will be done along woods roads within the sale area.

No pole skidding will be allowed unless special permission is granted by Forester.

Upon completion, all woods roads and access points shall be leveled, reditched if necessary and returned to the condition prior to the sale.

Oak regeneration was marked with blue paint. Care should be taken to avoid cutting or damaging these stems.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed due to density and distribution of existing regeneration.

Access to the sale will require a temporary in stream crossing permit. Permit has been obtained by DNR, requirements therein to be followed by the contractor.
