




Tract 16-21 (Larch Madness) - Flambeau River State Forest



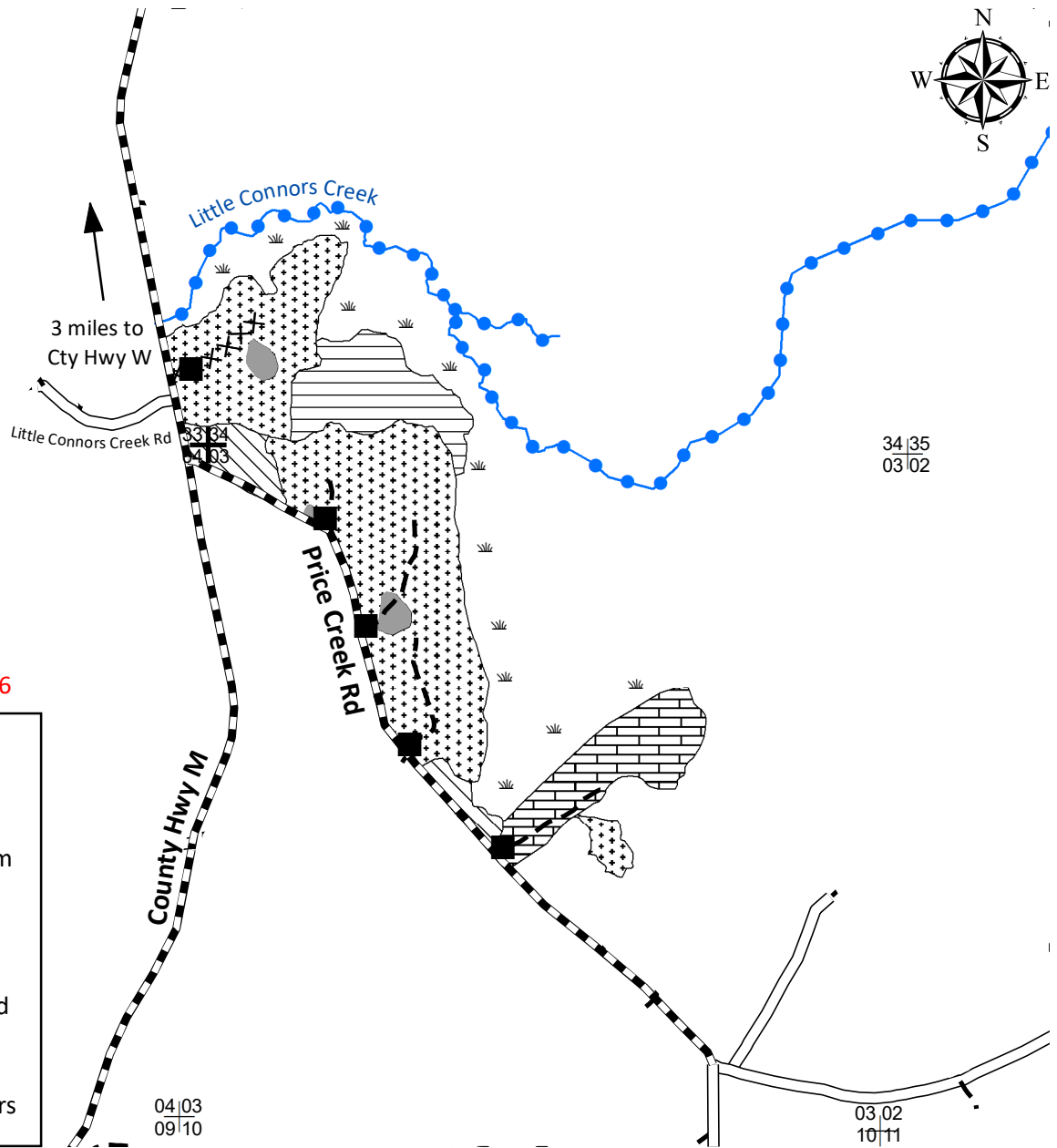
 **Coppice Area (82 acres)** – Bounded by red paint. Harvest all trees greater than 1” except for 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) cedar, 4) oak, 5) cherry

 **Selection Area (10 acres)** – Bounded by red paint. Harvest all orange marked trees. Do not cut snags or cull trees.









 **Ash Removal Area (17 acres)** – Bounded by yellow paint. Harvest all trees greater than 1” except for 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) cedar, 4) yellow birch.

 **Larch Plantation (18 acres)** – No paint line. Harvest all trees within the larch plantation greater than 1”.
