Slash located within 100 feet of the Flambeau River shall be lopped and scattered to within two feet of the ground by contractor.

Roads/Access/Decking

All wood decked within 400 feet of the river must be removed prior to April 1st of each year.

BMP's

Two temporary instream crossings are required to access the sale area. All permit requirements shall be followed by contractor. The permits will be obtained by the DNR.

A pole ford or timber mats may be needed for the wet crossings indicated on the map. No dirt fill allowed.
