## Harvest Requirements

**Clear Cut:** Cut all stems 2" in diameter or larger except for oak, birch and pine. In addition, reserve all snags that do not pose a safety hazard.

Reserve Areas: No harvest or hauling activities permitted.

**Slash Treatment:** All slash must be pulled back a minimum of 6' from all woods roads and lopped and scattered to within 2' of ground level.

**Private Lands Roads:** Access into a portion of the sale would be improved using a private lands woods road. Utilization of private lands roads must secure by the purchaser. Contact DNR Forester Jim Kujala for landowner contact information. Rehab of any private lands woods roads will be included in contract at signing.

## **Additional Requirements:**

- 3 Year Contract Period: June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026 End Date
- Harvesting operation may occur during dry or frozen ground conditions
- Oak Wilt Restrictions: No sale activities April 15<sup>th</sup>-July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- No harvest or hauling activities during WI "9 Day Deer Rifle Season"
- No machine operation within 15' of any interior or exterior wetlands.
- Decking may only occur within clear cut boundaries. New turn arounds or decking locations will be at the approval of a DNR Forester.
- Utilization Standards: 4" D.I.B
- All slash must always be kept clear of travel ways and out of wetlands and riparian areas.
- All road maintenance and rehabilitation post-harvest is the purchaser's responsibility. Roads will be left in an equal or improved state post-harvest.
- Any disturbed roads or landing areas will be re-seeded post-harvest with loggers mix if necessary.
- Sale will be billed using mill ticket system.
- No bid bond required, a performance bond of 15% of the total sale bid value will be required. 3 year contract period
- Equipment must be clean of dirt and debris before entering sale area
- Do not disturb survey corners, monuments, or surrounding witness trees
