BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

1. Bidding Procedure for Timber Sales
 - a. Bids will be made by species for each tract.
 - b. Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.
 - c. The **high bidder** will be determined by the **greatest total bid** for each tract.
 - d. Bids will be opened in random order.
 - e. **Bidders in attendance (virtual)** can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Bidders must identify themselves by clearly stating their name, address, and telephone number PRIOR to a bid being opened to withdraw their bid from consideration.
2. Bids may be made on one or more tracts.
3. Submit each bid in an **individual sealed envelope** marked “Bid for Timber Stumpage” with the timber sale name, and tract number on the outside. Wisconsin DNR Timber Sale Bid Forms must be used to make bids on DNR timber sales and is included with the individual sale prospectus
4. A per unit bid must be made on every item on a tract. No “zero” bids for any species or products will be accepted.
5. Winning bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid opening and must sign the timber sale contract and submit an acceptable performance bond within 6 weeks of the bid opening. If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state or GNA timber sales for a two-year period.
6. A **Performance Bond or Letter of Credit** is required before awarding of contract. The bond shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid value or a minimum of \$1000.00, whichever is greater. The bond will be held intact by the Department of Natural Resources until the satisfactory completion of the timber sale contract. Performance bonds in a form of other than cash for these sales must expire no earlier than **1-year past contract expiration date**.
7. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

SALES TAX CERTIFICATION

1. A [Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate](https://www.revenue.wi.gov/DORForms/s-211-inst.pdf) must be provided at the signing of the contract. This certificate is required to cover a contractor or individual reselling stumpage harvested for firewood/fuelwood and mills and manufacturing facilities. UTILIZATION

1. All trees designated for cutting will be utilized to standard specified on each sale prospectus/map.

SCALING AND PAYMENT

1. If eligible for deferred payment option, payment for timber removed from site must be made within 30 days after invoice.
2. If not eligible for deferred payment option, no wood will be hauled from the sale area until advanced payment is made.
3. If sold as a lump sum sale, payment in full must be made on entire sale, or by the cutting block, or by some other means as mutually agreed upon by Department of Natural Resources and contractor.

4. The mill scale ticket system will be used as the preferred method of sale administration. Other scaling systems may be used at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.
5. If a woods scale system is used, all cordwood or logs will be piled for scaling. Piles will be level and square with at least 5 cords per pile or 3 MBF. At least 10 cords or 5 MBF will be piled before a scale is requested. Scaling requests must be made at least one day in advance.
6. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller.
7. Scribner Decimal C Log Rule shall be used for scaling logs. Conversion from MBF to cords or cords to MBF shall be 2.44 cords per MBF for softwoods and 2.2 cords per MBF for hardwoods.
8. Weight scale conversions will be at rates as specified in the Department of Natural Resources timber sale handbook listed below, unless the individual timber sale has specific mixed species pro-rates/conversions.

CONTRACT PERIOD

1. All contracts offered during this bid opening will expire as indicated on individual timber sale maps.

CONTRACT EXTENSIONS

Contract extensions will not be granted without a justifiable reason. Justification will be determined by the Department of Natural Resources. Contract expiration dates are given on the individual timber sale. Contract extensions are not guaranteed. All extensions, if granted, will be for 1 year. Extension requests will be considered with the following conditions:

One and Two-year contracts

- 1st extension – 5% increase in stumpage rate
- 2nd extension – an additional 10% increase in stumpage rate

Three and Four-year Contracts

- 1st extension – 15% increase in stumpage rate (only 1 extension granted)

OTHER CONDITIONS

Insurance

Contractor claiming exemption, independent status, the contractor/purchaser will be required to submit a signed, notarized affidavit that affirms their exempt status pursuant to the criteria listed in section 102.07(7)(b), of the Wisconsin Statutes.

||||| Clearcut (Blocks C-F) - Harvest all species with one or more merchantable sticks. Do not harvest trees in block F that could damage the pasture fence when felled. Block C has been scarified by the Department. Site maintenance-Block C harvest all hardwoods greater than 2" DBH, Block E harvest all trees greater than 2" DBH.

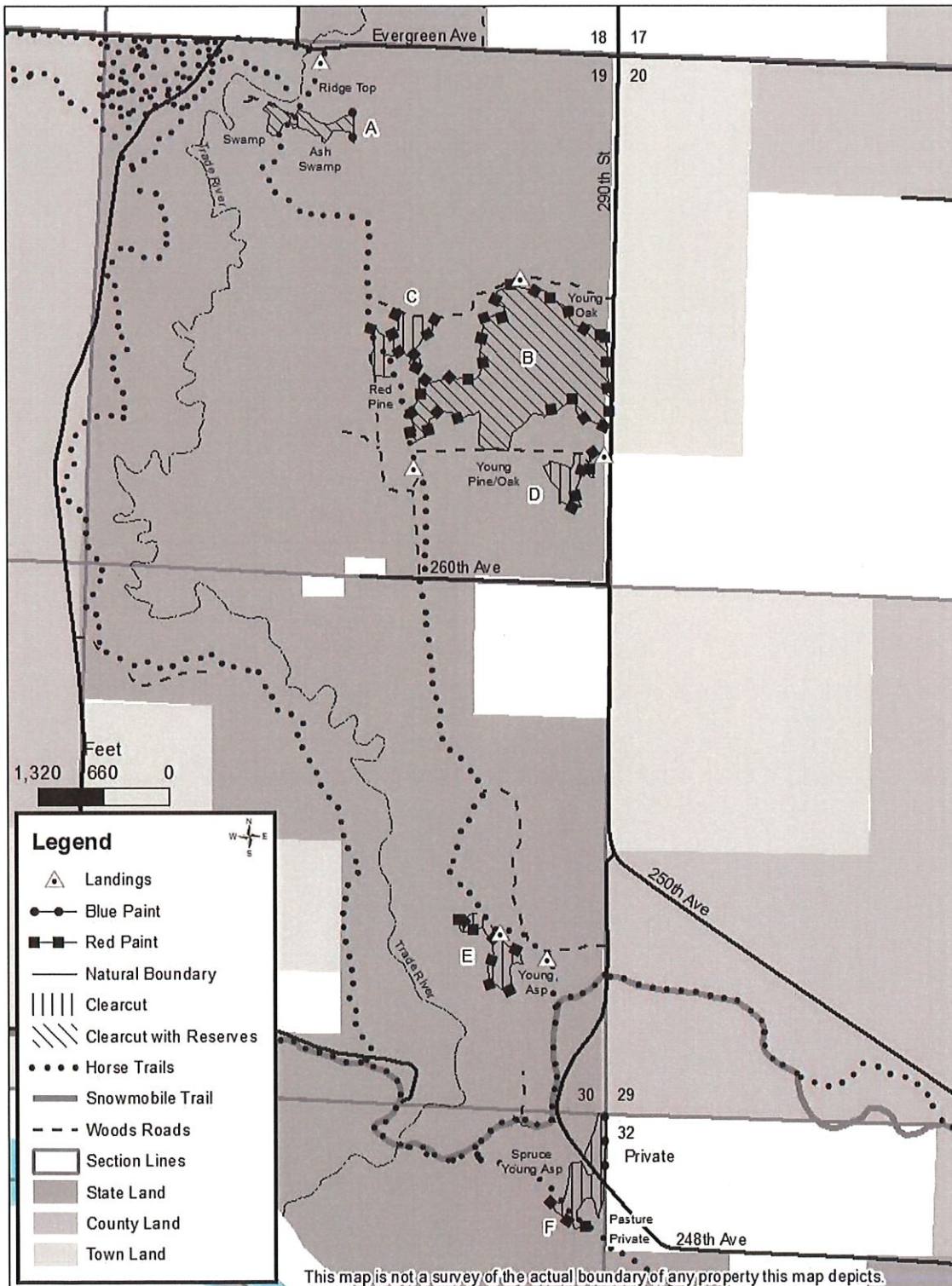
/// Clearcut with Reserves (Blocks A & B) – Harvest all trees with one or more merchantable sticks except white pine.

- Utilization: Hardwoods-4" top DIB, Pine-6" top DIB.
- This is a mill scale sale.
- Maximum stump height shall be 10 inches.
- Do not harvest red or blue marked trees.
- Slash shall be lopped and scattered to a maximum height not to exceed three feet and kept within the sale boundaries.
- The locations, building, and maintenance of new landings, roads, and accesses are the responsibility of the purchaser and are subject to approval by the Department.
- All existing roads and trails shall be kept free of debris and open to allow for normal use throughout the harvest. Be aware of the recreational trail uses in the sale area, including hiking, equestrian, and snowmobile. If harvesting in the winter, the snowmobile trail shall remain snow covered when it is open for use.
- Harvesting shall be completed in a systematic and progressive manner. Harvesting shall be completed in a block prior to moving to another block unless otherwise approved by the Department. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods, a mid-contract "pull-out" inspection meeting will be required. Notice shall be given by the contractor a minimum of two working days prior to moving equipment off-site
- Leave all snags where they are not a safety risk to the operators. **Fell all snags within 75 feet of the horse/snowmobile trails and town roads.**
- Avoid damage to advanced regeneration or trees not designated for harvest.
- Contractor is enc to deliver all pin oak directly to a wood processing facility, minimizing the spread of oak wilt. Only pin oak that is peeled or has loose bark may be sorted and sold as firewood.
- To avoid spreading invasive plant materials, all equipment must be cleaned prior to entering and leaving the sale area.
- All cut conifer products must be removed from the sale area within two weeks after being cut between May 15 and August 15.
- Seasonal Restrictions – No harvest activity allowed in block A from March 1 to November 1 due to recreation and a threatened bird. No harvest activity allowed from April 15-July 15 in the remainder of the harvest area due to oak wilt.**
- Avoid impacts to and do not drive equipment on structural ruins (depressions, foundations, etc.) in block F.**

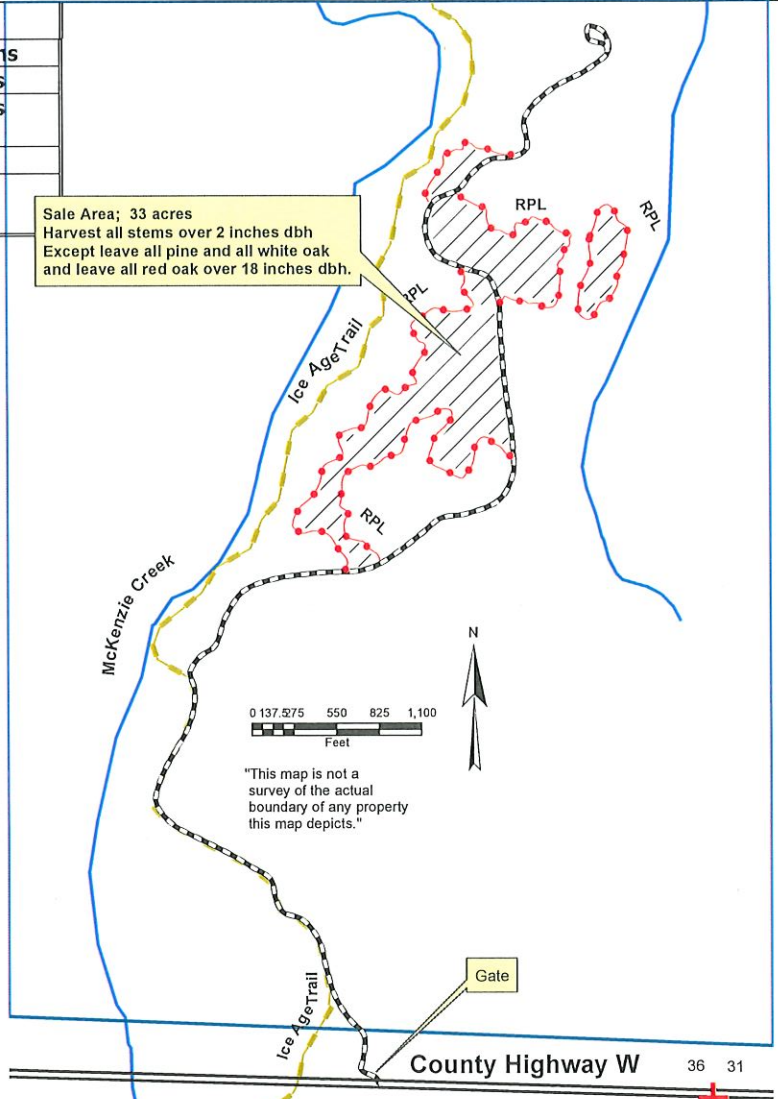
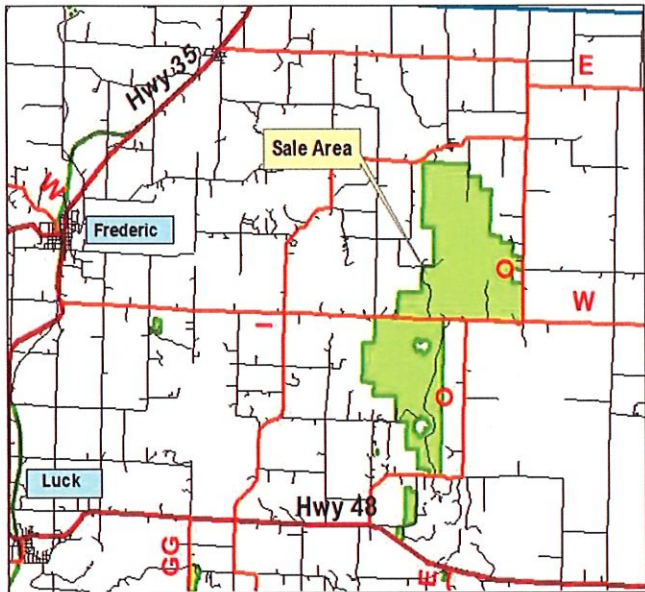

1. Sale Area; Cut all stems 2" DBH and larger except leave all den trees, all pine, all white oak, and leave all red oak over 18 inches dbh.
2. Cutting, skidding, or hauling **allowed only from July 15 to spring breakup (usually mid march)** when dry or frozen and rutting will not occur. Operations must cease if rutting occurs. **No operations during regular gun deer season.**
3. Care must be taken to avoid damage to any residual trees. No tops or trees are to be left hanging in standing trees and slash must be lopped to below 3 feet and kept within sale area. If excessive damage occurs to residual trees, equipment and/or operators will be restricted.
4. Utilization: 4" top.
5. Access is off of County Highway W. Landings will be in existing landings, sale areas or along existing roads. No new roads will be built in the sale areas. Roads and landings will be repaired to prior or better condition if necessary.

Special Contract Restrictions:

1. **Winter Logging Area. Logging permitted only on frozen ground.**
2. Site Maintenance required. Sever all ironwood and muscle wood stems 2" and larger.
3. Openings must be free of all logging debris prior to the sale being closed.
4. All sawtimber will be scaled on site by the forester before hauling.
5. Harvest all species to a 4" top.
6. Sale includes sawtimber, all bolts shall be piled with small end facing one direction. The State reserves the right to inspect bolt piles prior to hauling to assure no sawtimber is included.
7. No whole tree skidding allowed. Pole skidding allowed.
8. Damage to residual trees will result in additional skidding restrictions.
9. Operation will be stopped, if in the opinion of the forester unnecessary damage occurs.
10. All slash shall be lopped, scattered, or crushed to within 2' of the ground. No slash is to be left in any wetland.

4. All sawtimber will be scaled on site by the forester before hauling.
5. No ground skidding, harvest limited to short wood forwarding only.

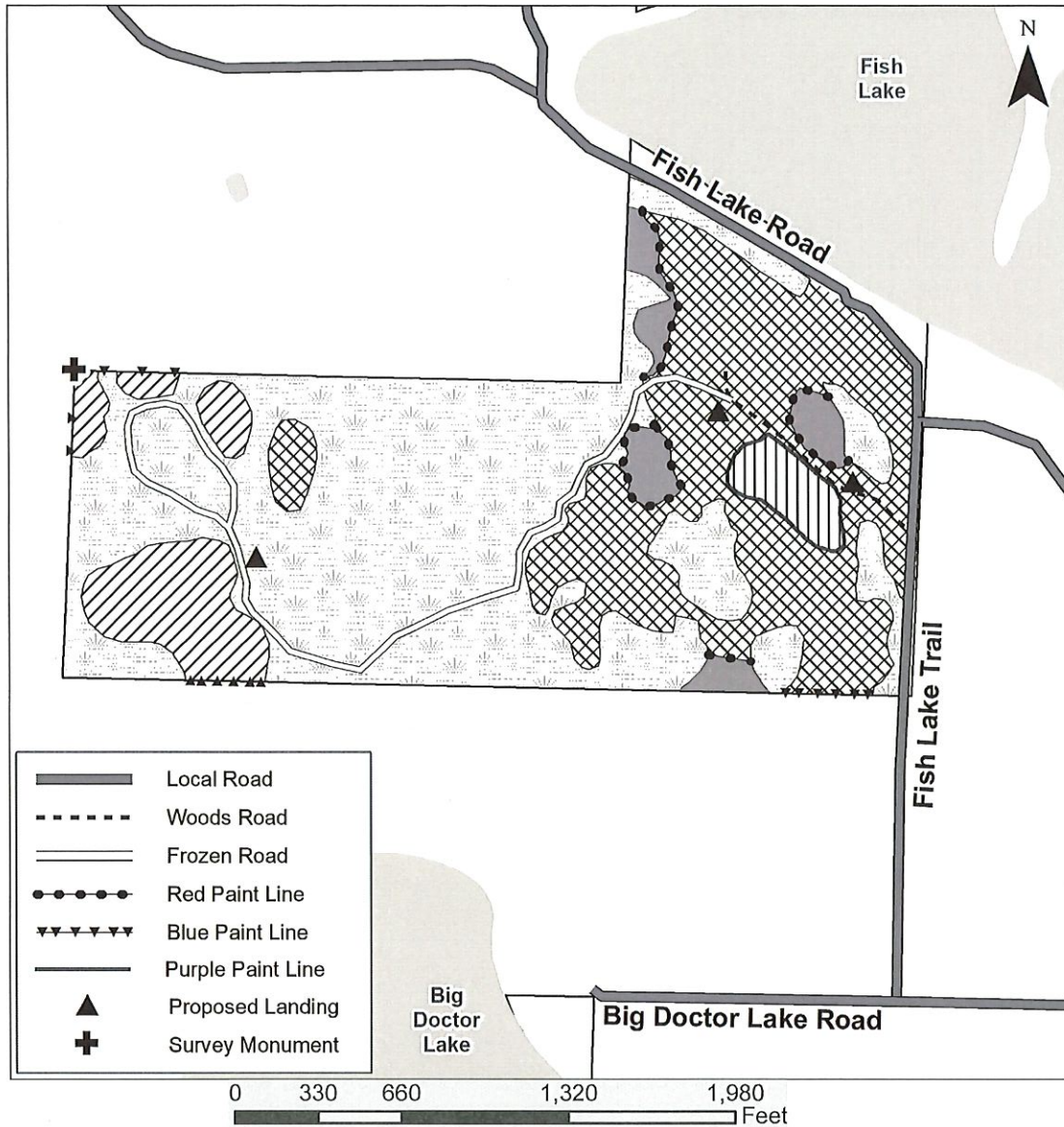

1. **Seed Tree Unit – Scarification site. No cutting allowed until scarification is completed by DNR during non-frozen conditions. Site will be scheduled for scarification after contractor provides timeline for harvest. Harvest required within 1 year of scarification.**
2. **No harvesting within 15' or wetlands.**
3. Although there are no specific date restrictions on this sale, during wet periods of the year the soils may become soft and susceptible to damage. Operations will be suspended during these periods.
4. Slash shall be lopped and scattered to within 3' of the ground throughout the sale area.

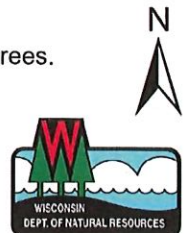
