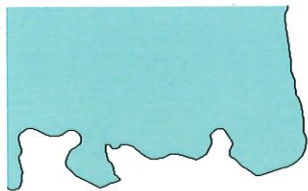


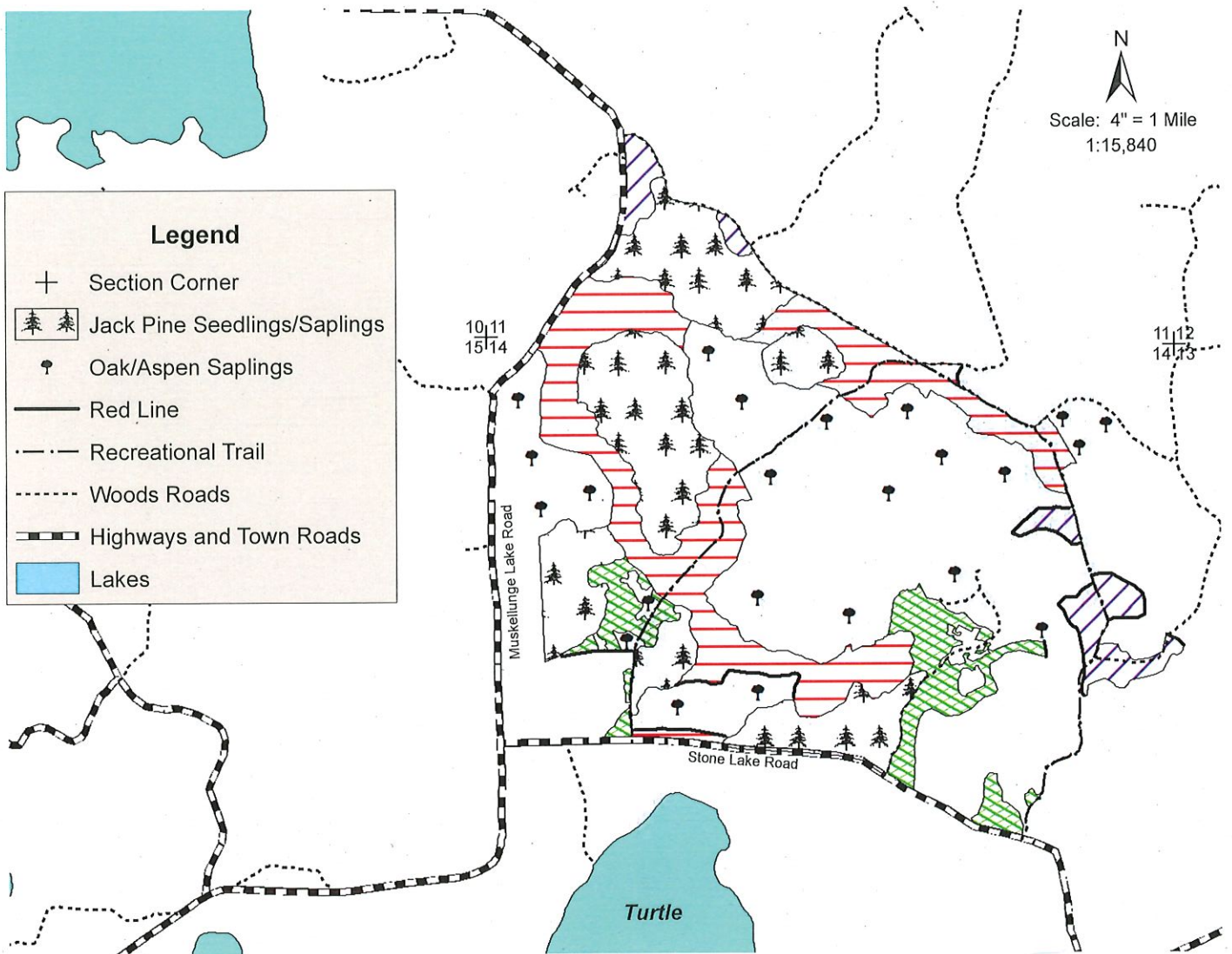

- Pine Thinning Area (23 Acres): Cut all trees marked with orange paint.
- Oak Regeneration Area (68 Acres): Cut all trees except red pine, white pine, spruce and trees marked with purple paint.
- Mixed Regeneration Area (16 Acres): Cut all trees except unmarked pine and those marked with purple paint. Cut all 1-5" aspen and maple.

**Note: All harvesting, skidding, or road building is allowed August 15 - April 14.

The cutting area is approximately 107 acres.

The contract period expires on December 31, 2025.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

⁴Volume includes 59% red maple and 41% white birch. Volume includes approximately 6 MBF of potential white birch logs. Total sale volume equates to 41.5 tons/acre or 16.35 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. **LUMP SUM SALE**. One-third of the total lump sum bid value must be paid prior to starting. The remaining amounts will be paid as each third of the sale area is completed, with the final payment made before the last 1/3 of the acreage is harvested. All trees are to be pre-approved prior to cutting if not marked or designated to be cut. Any residual trees cut, pushed over or damaged are to be decked, scaled and billed for in addition to lump sum bid value. Any trees cut without approval will subject the contractor to penalties and fines.
2. Seasonal Restrictions: All harvesting activity, including road building, is allowed August 15 – April 14. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead standing snags. No biomass harvesting allowed on this sale.
3. No tops or slash allowed in adjacent sapling stands. Slash within 50 feet of the town roads and recreational trail must be lopped and scattered within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet from the edges of those areas.
4. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not cut trees marked with red, blue, or purple paint. Ignore old, faded paint on trees.
5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
6. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
