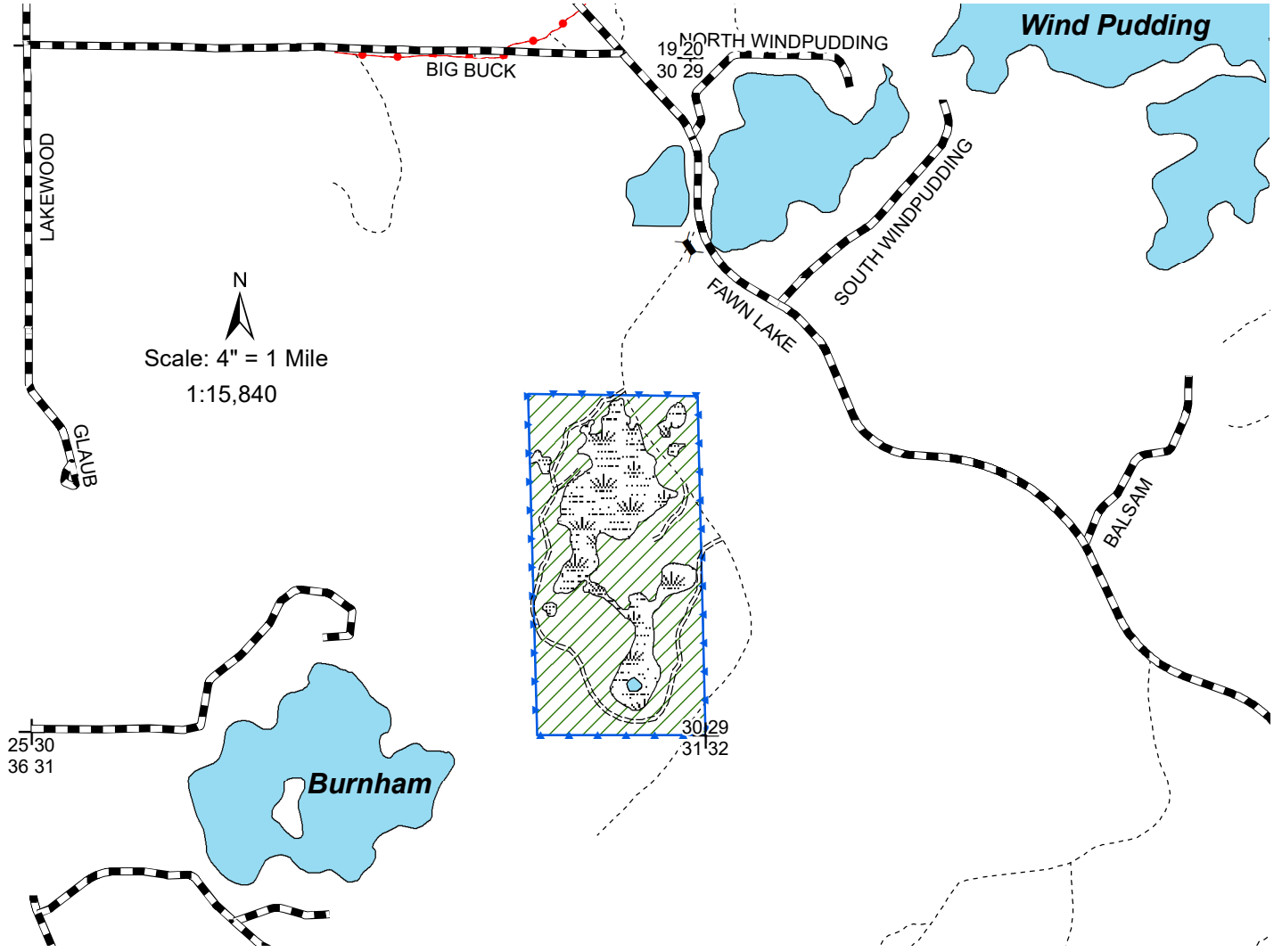

Harvest Area (56 Acres): Cut all aspen, maple, ironwood, and fir >1" DBH. Do not cut any oak, pine, spruce, or birch.

**Harvesting is allowed July 15th through April 15th.**

No bid bond required.

The cutting area is approximately 56 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum top diameter of 4" will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvest is not allowed.

The total sale volume equates to approximately 69.91 tons/acre or 31 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. Do not operate equipment or cut any trees within 15 feet of any ephemeral pond or wetland. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. Harvesting or road building is allowed from July 16<sup>th</sup> – April 14<sup>th</sup> due to oak wilt.
3. All slash must be pulled back at least 25 feet away from any road or trail.
4. No slash allowed across any blue line, or within any wetland. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lay within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet away from the adjacent private lands.
5. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up.
6. The contractor will be responsible for gaining access to the sale through private land.
7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
8. Access to the sale will be through private land. Securing access will be the responsibility of the logger, but adjacent landowners have been receptive to granting access. Landowner names and phone numbers will be available upon request.

**Notice:** Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
