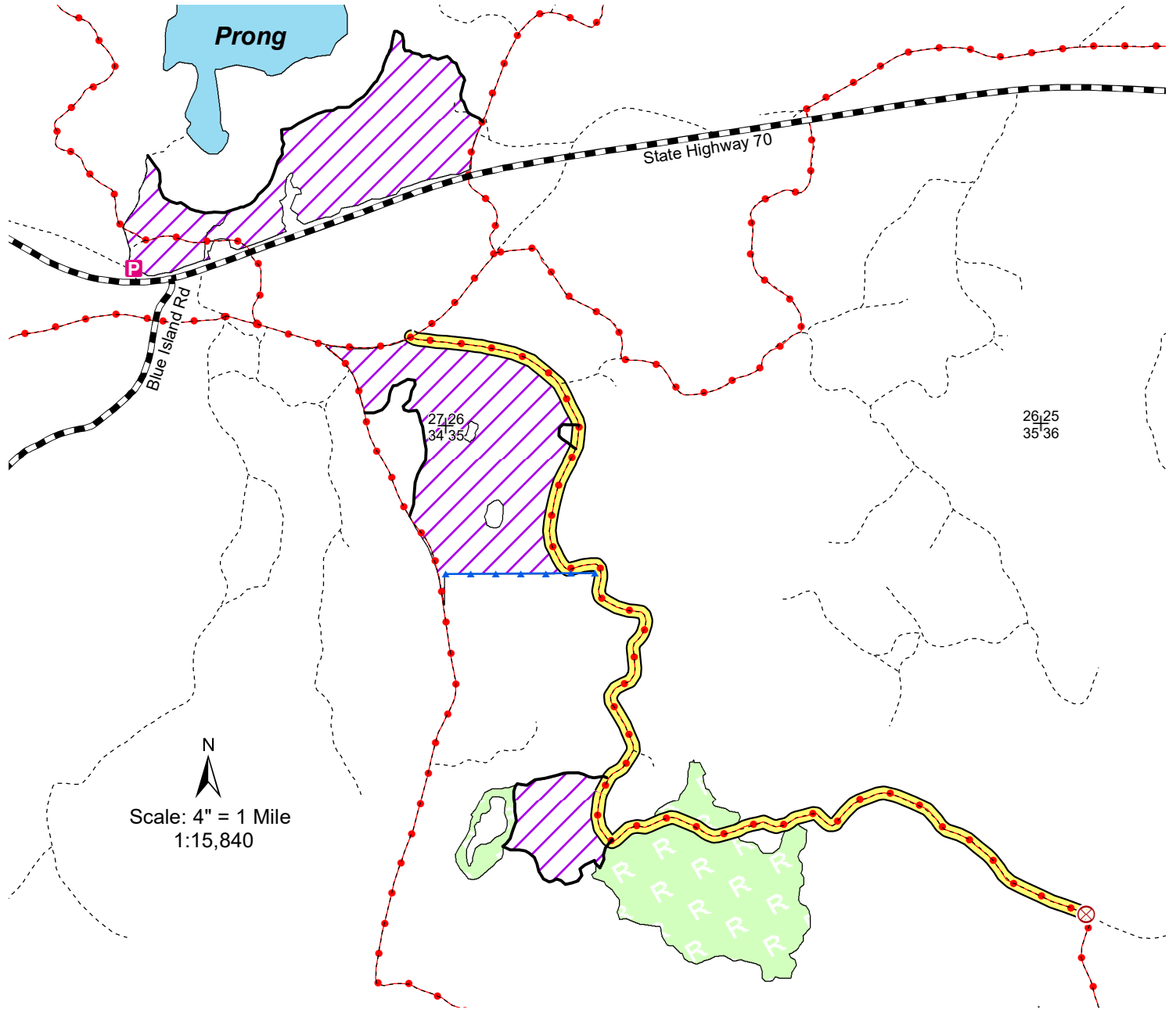

- Harvest Area (131 Acres): Cut all merchantable trees except green marked trees, red oak > 15" DBH, and pine > 20" DBH. Cut all 1-5" aspen, maple and balsam fir.
- Reserve Area (50 Acres): DO NOT CUT.
- Trail Expansion (Approx. 2 Miles): Cut all merchantable trees within 25 feet on both sides of the snowmobile trail as measured from the trails center.

Harvesting is allowed July 16th through April 14th.

The entire sale area lies within Management Area 5: Big Arbor Vitae Loamy Hills - Forest Production

The total sale area is approximately 181 acres which includes 50 acres of Green Tree Retention (GTR). All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

¹ Approximately 88% white pine and 12% red pine. Includes potential for 117 MBF white pine sawlogs and 15 MBF red pine sawlogs.

² Approximately 45% red oak, 22% hard maple, 20% red maple, and 13% white birch. Includes potential for 19 MBF red oak sawlogs, 13 MBF hard maple sawlogs, and 7 MBF red maple sawlogs.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 67.9 tons/acre or 29.3 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. **Seasonal Restriction: Oak Wilt Restriction: Cutting, skidding, or road building is allowed between July 16th and April 14th.**
2. **The area of the sale labelled "Trail Expansion" must be completely cut within the first year of the sale contract. The cut area includes all merchantable trees within 25 feet of each side of the snowmobile trail as measured from the trails center.**
3. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
4. Cutting must be concurrent for all species, including 1-5" DBH trees where designated.
5. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard.
6. Slash within 50 feet of all roads and trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
