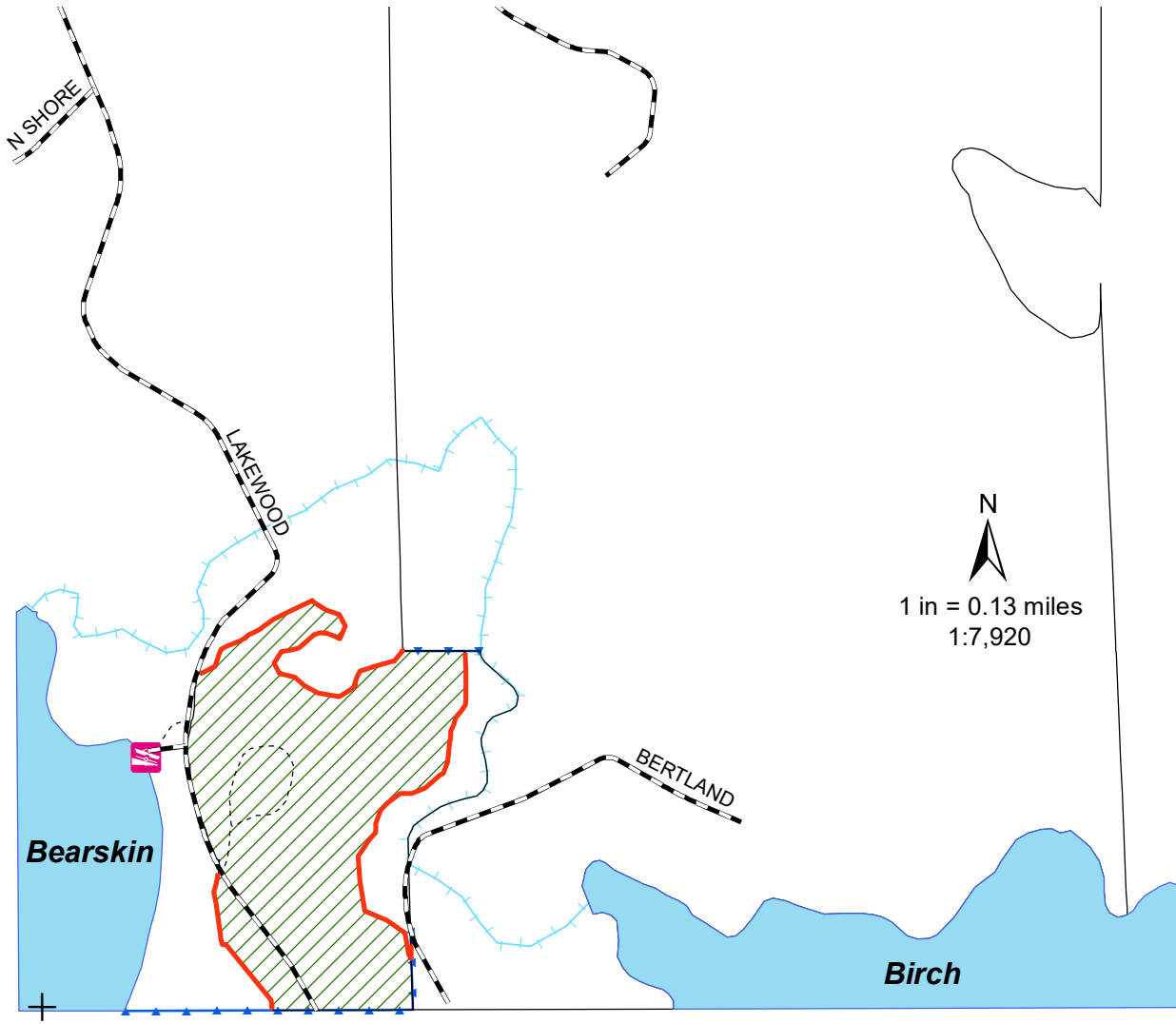









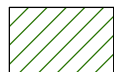

Harvest Area (21 Acres): Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Cut all merchantable aspen, fir, ash, ironwood and maple. Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.

to July 15th due to oak wilt restrictions**

No bid bond is required.

15% of the total sale bid value or \$1000.00, whichever is greater, will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 21 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Biomass (whole-tree) utilization is allowed.

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<sup>1</sup>Mixed Hardwood volume includes 60% Hard Maple, 12% Red Maple and Aspen, 7% Red Oak and White Ash, 1% White Birch and Basswood. Volumes include the following Log estimates: Sugar Maple 23 MBF, Red Oak 15 MBF, Basswood 5 MBF , Red Maple 4 MBF, White Ash 3 MBF      MX Conversion factor is 2.4 tons/ acre

Sale contains approximately 57 tons/acre or 26 cords/acre for all species.

Special Conditions:

- 1. Oak Wilt Seasonal restriction: No equipment to be used during the period April 15 to July 15.**
2. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they are a safety hazard.
3. Slash within 50 feet of all roads, trails, private land, and waterbodies must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting. No slash allowed across any blue line, or within any wetland or waterbody.
4. Follow WI BMP's for water quality at all times.
5. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not damage residual trees
6. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved by the timber sale administrator.
7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
