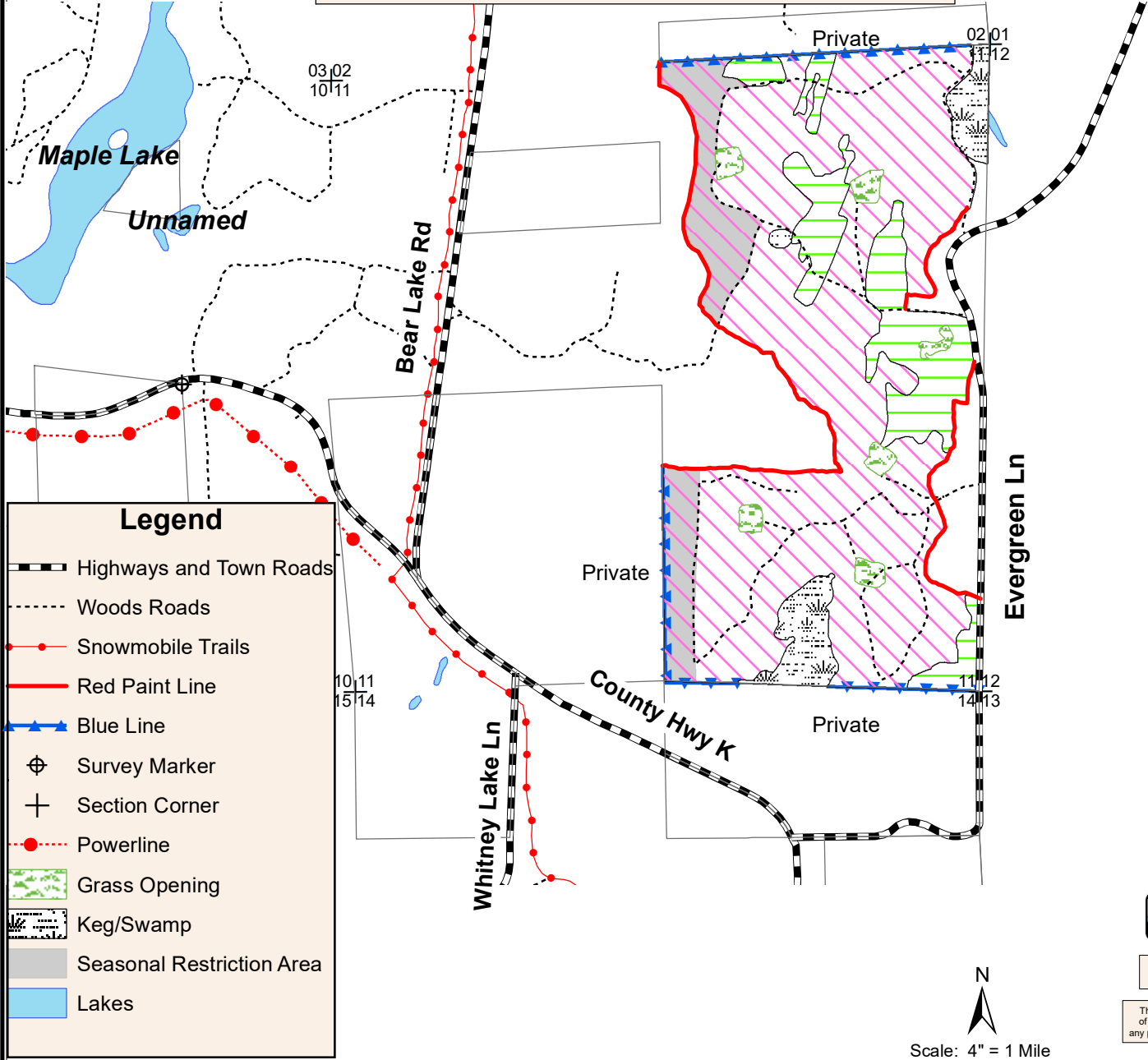

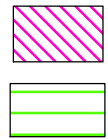

Aspen Area (198 acres): Cut all aspen, maple, & balsam fir 1" and greater in diameter as well as all merchantable oak, white birch, & trees marked with orange paint.



Red Pine Area (39 acres): Cut same as above (* sub-merch trees do not need to be harvested from within the pine plantations*)

Biomass Restricted Soils - No whole tree harvesting

**-Seasonal Restriction on Portions of Sale (Shaded Area Only ~28 Acres)-
No Harvesting Operations Allowed from April 15 - July 15 (Oak Wilt)**

**-Evergreen Road is weight limit posted-

Evergreen

The cutting area is approximately 237 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvesting is not allowed.

² Approximately 45% red oak, 22% white birch, 22% soft maple, and 11% hard maple. Includes the potential for 26 MBF of red oak sawlogs

Note: Total sale volume equates to 63.5 tons/acre or 27.6 cords/acre

**-Seasonal Restriction on Portions of this sale (Shaded Area Only ~ 28 Acres)-
No harvesting, skidding, or road building allowed April 15 – July 15 due to the risk of oak wilt.**

**-Evergreen Road is weight limit posted -
Wood will need to be hauled out via Bear Lake Road**

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species. Do not damage residual trees.
2. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
3. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees, unless they pose a hazard to operator safety.
4. Slash within 50 feet of all town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10' behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
5. Do not harvest trees or operate equipment within 15 feet of any ephemeral pond. Do not deposit any slash or tops in them.
6. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up.
7. All roads and landings must be returned to pre-harvest conditions or better.

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
