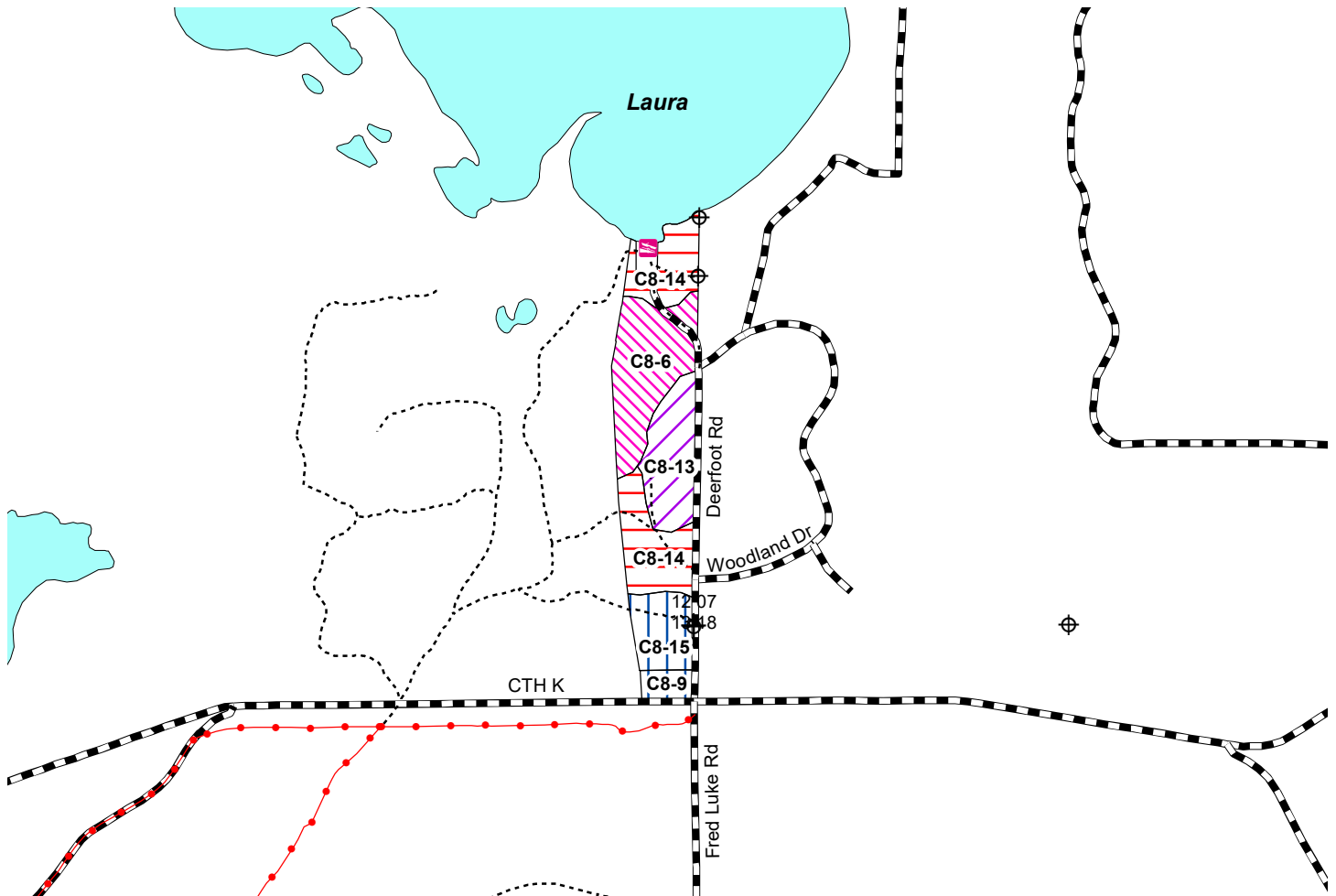

Stand 6 (13 acres) Red Oak – 122 y.o. This well stocked stand of large sawlog red oak will be marked following the Common Priorities for Removal and Retention with the objective of enhancing the growth of large vigorous trees.

Stand 13 (9 acres) Aspen – 46 y.o. This stand of aspen will be undergo a coppice regeneration harvest while maintaining scattered sawlog white pine as reserves.

Stand 14 (14 acres) Northern Hardwood. This well stocked stand of large sawlog northern hardwoods, dominated by sugar maple and basswood, will be marked following the Common Priorities for Removal and Retention with the objective of enhancing the growth of large vigorous trees.

Stand 15 (6 acres) and Stand 9 (2 acres) Northern Hardwood. This medium stocked stand of small sawlog northern hardwoods will undergo a light thinning to encourage the growth of large diameter trees. Stand 9 is managed under the Scenic Resource guidelines.
