PACKERS TO PLANT TREES DONATED FROM 'FIRST DOWNS FOR TREES' PROGRAM OUTSIDE LAMBEAU FIELD ATRIUM **THURSDAY**

This year's 720 donated trees will provide total lifetime benefits of \$2,346,887

The Green Bay Packers, SCA, Green Bay Packaging Inc., the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and the U.S. Forest Service will mark another successful year of the "First Downs for Trees" program by planting trees in front of the Lambeau Field Atrium on Thursday, May 29, at 10 a.m.





This year, the program donated 720 trees to 18 local communities including: Allouez, Ashwaubenon, Bellevue, De Pere, Green Bay, Hobart, Howard, Lawrence, Ledgeview, Morrison, Pittsfield, Pulaski, Scott, Suamico, Town of Wrightstown, Village of Wrightstown, Brown County and the Oneida Tribe.

The addition of two new corporate sponsors, SCA and Green Bay Packaging, Inc., provided the program with additional funds, resulting in the planting of even more trees in Brown County communities.

Six nurseries, McKay Nursery in Waterloo, Meacham Nursery in Green Bay, Midpark Nursery in Fond du Lac, Schichtel's Nursery in Springville, N.Y., Silver Creek Nursery in Manitowoc and Tillman Wholesale Growers in Green Bay provided the trees. A combination of elm, linden, lilac, oak, honey locust and flowering crab trees are among the species that were planted.
